Happy Birthday Gemini! For those born between May 20th - June 19th

The Key Phrase is: I Think. The astrological glyph is the Twins. Gemini is a mutable (malleable, flexible), air (intellect, detached, fleeting) sign located in the 1st quadrant (self oriented/personal) of the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Because Gemini resides in the 3rd house of the zodiac and is ruled by the planet Mercury, communication, thoughts and learning are most important to Gemini. Intellectual stimulation is as basic to a Gemini as water is to a Cancer. There is an inherent need to know and understand just about everything. The sign of Aries inhabits the 1st house of the natural zodiac. That first house is the cusp of the Ascendant or as many already knows as the Rising Sign. Because Gemini arrives immediately after the earthy 2nd house Taurus who asks, "What should I possess or own and how will I meet my security issues"? Gemini desires to communicate and formulate ideas about what those security needs are and to present them to other; most often in the early school years when we accumulate a lot of information about life and the world in a short time frame. Gemini wants to collect data and information about everything. It is not uncommon for a Gemini to be watching television, listening to music and reading a book all at the same time!

Gemini is a dual sign...dual meaning the astrological glyph (symbol) for Gemini looks like this "II"...like the Roman Numeral II - The Twins. Duality means to have a double nature, character or purpose and/or is composed of two parts. Gemini's certainly has the reputation for the ability to change their personality in an instant and can scatter their

energies. Their duality enables them to see two sides of problem or situation and to project outward, the two aspects of their persona as well.

Gemini resides in the 3rd house of the zodiac wheel and so relates to siblings, the neighborhood, early educational experiences, teachers, short distance travel and automobiles. If you have no planets in your 3rd^d house, look to where the ruler of that house (the cusp ruler) is located and, along with its aspects, will give you a glimpse of where your communication style and learning experiences are found.

Gemini as related to health issues coincides with the lungs, shoulders, hands and fingers and the nervous system. Respiratory troubles may be more common with Gemini. Sometimes Gemini's just can sit still because they have a lot of physical and mental nervous energy. Gemini's are distinguishable by their youthful exuberance. Gemini always looks a bit younger than their chronological age. Some accuse Gemini of being fickle and/or gossipy....well, Mercury, Gemini's ruling planet does have wings and was considered to be a "messenger". It isn't always about "gossip" and more likely about the need to communicate and share information.

Gemini's polar opposite (3rd house - communication, thoughts, ideas, early education, short distance travel and siblings) is the mutable, fire sign Sagittarius (9th house- higher learning, long distance travel, publishing and the law). The integration of "my ideas and beliefs" versus "other's ideas, beliefs and philosophies' is one life lesson for Gemini, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart.

THE LOVERS - Number VI - Gemini

The Lovers card depicts the unclothed bodies of two lovers, a man and a woman. They bare their souls' to each other. The man gazes upon the woman while the woman looks up to the spirit, Archangel Gabriel. As the angel hovers over the couple, arms and wings spread as if blessing the pair. The sun shines above his head, bringing warmth and security and light. The leaves on the tree mirror the hair on the Angels head...a symbol of the fires of passion burning deep within the lovers' soul. This sun and fire is also symbolic of our life force and our impulse to create. The fertile grass beneath their feet, and fruit on the tree suggests growth and happiness.

However, with all the cards or aspects in a birth chart, there can be negative manifestations of the symbolism of this card. The snake coiled in the tree behind the

woman is a gentle reminder of the story of Adam and Eve and the temptations we may be faced with. There are 3 people in this card...not two. In this regard, the third person could be an intruder to the relationship.

Triangulation can occur when there is a choice to be made between two lovers. The Lovers card "is" a card of choices and decisions. Choices can be between sexual love and spiritual love although they are closely related. The card can imply the struggling temptation between our immediate material desires versus staying true to ourselves on our spiritual path. There can be a conflict between different forms of attraction. Gemini is a sign of duality and choices.

When we see the Lovers card in a reading, it can augur the coming or presence of a Soul Mate relationship. It mostly represents our most intensely intimate and sexual relationships. A loving, committed relationship is indicated. Clear, perceptive communication usually brings a beneficial result. Because this is a card of choices, when we see it in a reading it could test our personal beliefs as well as our values within that relationship. We may need to choose between with is right and what is wrong for us. This could be an ethical or moral choice. Please see what I have written about THE DEVIL card which is the symbolic opposite of the THE LOVERS at www.FuchsiaStars.com site listed under Articles/Venus/Pluto.

In the Lovers card, the urge for union is rather powerful and it takes love to the highest spiritual level, symbolic of the Angel. When The Lovers appear, it always refers to a relationship based on a deep, unwavering love. There is no force more powerful. It doesn't always have to be a sexual relationship although the mutual sexual attraction can be unrivaled.

The Lovers card and the number 6 are all about unconditional love, strength, wisdom and compassion. How often do we give love without judgment or strings attached to it?

COMPLANTING MOON (Deer)

In Native American Astrology, those born from May 21 - June 20th are born under the Complanting Moon and their animal totem is the Deer. Their colors are green and white and the are included in the Butterfly Elemental Clan.

If they learn to develop them, Deer people can have healing abilities and are usually very intuitive. They have sensitive hearing and do not like loud noises. Deer are gentle, loving and kind animals. They often have the ability to create items of beauty from ordinary objects. They are resourceful people. Deer people also make good friends. They are very lively in speech and in actions and they have a very high energy level. Deer are known for their beauty, grace, sexuality and cunning. Deer is the epitome of both masculine and feminine energy and suggests their dual nature. Deer people have the ability to captivate others with their eloquent speech as well as with their beautiful bodies.

As part of the Butterfly Clan, this increases their chance for "flitting" from one flower to the next or from one idea to another examining each and every thing as they flutter along.

June 19, 2006 Uranus turns retrograde until November 19, 2006 when it turns direct at 10 Pisces 48'. Electric Uranus begins the month at 14 Pisces 35' and ends the month at 14 Pisces 41 rx.

June 22, **2006** - **Sun enters watery Cancer**. Happy Birthday Cancer! More will be discussed about Cancer in our next issue.

June 25, 2006 - 03 Cancer 58" NEW MOON - New Beginnings in Lunar ruled Cancer; home, family, food and nurturing are highlighted.

June 25 2006 - When Venus enters Gemini, it's ready to communicate. Venus in Gemini has an inquisitive and youthful love nature. Venus in the sign of Gemini prefers a witty and younger partner. Having two forms of income is likely.

Jupiter continues to retrograde. Jupiter will travel backwards through July 6th until it stations direct at 8 Scorpio 58'. Jupiter begins the month at 10 Scorpio 47' and ends the month at 09 Scorpio 02'.

Saturn, lord of karma begins the month at 7 Leo 04' and ends the month at 10 Leo 04'.

Neptune continues to retrograde on until October 29th, 2006. Currently at19 Aquarius 47 and ends the month at 19 Aquarius 26'

Pluto continues to retrograde at 25 Sagittarius 49' conjunct the Galactic Center. Pluto will continue his backward journey until September 3, 2006 when he turns direct at 24 Sagittarius 04'.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

FULL MOON - June 11, 2006 - 20 Sagittarius 41'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the June 11th Full Moon falls in the sign of Sagittarius, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Sagittarius is a mutable, fire sign, and resides in the 9th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by Jupiter. In the sign of Sagittarius, this Full Moon will intensify the desire for the truth and justice! Long distance travel, legal issues, philosophies and beliefs will be highlighted. A New Moon is always a new beginning.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 21 Sagittarius:

A CHILD AND A DOG WEARING BORROWED EYE GLASSES

The image of a dog and child playing appears to be carefree. Child-like innocence is highlighted. When wearing eyeglasses the child may not see especially clearly. These glasses may be too large for the child's face. Images will be distorted and judgment will be skewed.

Oftentimes we think someone is more intelligent than they are because they wear eyeglasses. When we wear the eyeglasses belonging to another our perception of our environment and others is altered and we may not see where we are going!

This image reminds me that we can filter our reality and see it differently, by temporarily altering it. Sometimes this new awareness benefits us to see nuances not previously known. Alternately, seeing reality through another lens can prove startling and also unsettling. Perhaps we are deceiving ourselves or spending too much time fantasizing.
