The Key Phrase is: I Think.

The astrological glyph is the Twins. Gemini is a mutable (malleable, flexible), air (intellect, detached, fleeting) sign located in the $1^{\rm st}$ quadrant (self oriented/personal) of the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Because Gemini resides in the 3rd house of the zodiac and is ruled by the planet Mercury, communication, thoughts and learning are most important to Gemini. Your birthstone is the Emerald. Intellectual stimulation is as basic to a Gemini as family and children are to a Cancer. There is an inherent need to know and

understand just about everything. The sign of Aries inhabits the 1st house of the natural zodiac. That first house is the cusp of the Ascendant or as many already knows as the Rising Sign. Because Gemini arrives immediately after the earthy 2nd house Taurus who asks, "What should I possess or own and how will I meet my security issues"? Gemini desires to communicate and formulate ideas about what those security needs are and to present them to others; most often in the early school years when we accumulate a lot of information about life and the world in a short time frame. Gemini wants to collect data and information about everything. It is not uncommon for a Gemini to be watching television, listening to music and reading a book all at the same time!

Gemini is a dual sign; dual meaning the astrological glyph (symbol) for Gemini looks like this "II"; resembling the Roman Numeral II - The Twins. Duality refers to having a double nature, character or purpose and/or is comprised of two parts. Gemini's certainly has the reputation for the ability to change their personality in an instant and may scatter their energies just as easily. Maintaining focus in early years particularly is sometimes difficult for Gemini. Their duality enables them to see two sides of problem or situation and to project outward the two aspects of their persona as well.

Gemini resides in the 3rd house of the zodiac wheel and so relates to siblings, the neighborhood, early educational experiences, teachers, short distance travel, the mind, news, siblings, cousins and automobiles. If you have an empty $3rd^d$ house (no planets in there), look to where the ruler of that house (the 3^{rd} cusp ruler) is located and, along with its aspects, will provide a glimpse of your communication style and learning experiences as well as the area of life these will be most utilized.

Gemini in relation to health issues coincides with the lungs, shoulders, hands and fingers and the nervous system. Respiratory troubles may be more common with Gemini. Sometimes Gemini's just can sit still because they have a lot of nervous physical and mental energy. Mercury ruled, Gemini's often become agitated for no obvious reason. Their mental energy becomes so compressed and like a coil, springs forth with terrific tension in order to unwind. Several cousins, my daughter and brother as well as friends are all Gemini's. I have a wonderful daughter and her temperament is so easy going. Whatever tragedy or annoyance she experiences rolls right off her shoulders. However, when she was little, like all Gemini's, her little alter ego would surface from time to time. Gemini's polar opposite (3rd house - communication, thoughts, ideas, early education, the immediate neighborhood, short distance travel and siblings) is the mutable, fire sign Sagittarius (9th house- higher learning, long distance travel, philosophy, publishing and the law). THE LOVERS - Number VI - Gemini

The Lovers card depicts the unclothed bodies of two lovers, a man and a woman. They bare their souls' to each other. The man gazes upon the woman while the woman looks up to the spirit, Archangel Gabriel. As the angel hovers over the couple, arms and wings spread as if blessing the pair. The sun shines above his head, bringing warmth and security and light. The leaves on the tree mirror the hair on the Angels head...a symbol of the fires of passion burning deep within the lovers' soul. This sun and fire is also symbolic of our life force and our impulse to create. The fertile grass beneath their feet, and fruit on the tree suggests growth and happiness.

However, as with every the card in the deck and aspects in a birth chart, there can be negative manifestations symbolic with this card. The snake coiled in the tree behind the woman is a gentle reminder of the story of Adam and Eve and the temptations we may be faced with. There are 3 people in this card...not two. In this regard, the third person could be an intruder to the relationship.

Triangulation can occur when there is a choice to be made between two lovers. The Lovers card "is" a card of choices and decisions. Conflicting values arise between sexual love and lust and spiritual love although they are closely related. The card can imply the struggling temptation between our immediate material desires versus staying true to ourselves on our spiritual path. There may be a conflict between different forms of attraction as Gemini is a sign of duality and choices.

When we see the Lovers card in a reading, it can augur the coming or presence of a "Soul Mate" relationship. It mostly represents our intensely intimate and sexual relationships. A loving, committed relationship is indicated and desired above all else. Clear, perceptive communication usually brings a beneficial result. Because this is a card of choices, when we see it in a reading it could test our personal beliefs as well as our values or

code of ethics within that relationship. We may need to choose between what really soothes our soul with what temptation, and what is ultimately detrimental. This could be an ethical or moral choice. Please see what I have written about **THE DEVIL** card (card 15 = 1+5=6) which is the symbolic opposite of **THE LOVERS** at www.FuchsiaStars.com site listed under Articles/Venus/Pluto.

If already involved in a committed relationship, there is mutual understanding and appreciation of each other. This card brings a happy outcome to the situation in question.

In the Lovers card, the urge for union is rather powerful and it takes love to the highest spiritual level, symbolic of the Angel symbolism. When The Lovers appear, it always refers to a relationship based on a deep, unwavering love. There is no force more powerful. It doesn't always have to be a sexual relationship although the mutual sexual attraction can be unrivaled.

The Lovers card and the number 6 are all about unconditional love, strength, wisdom, service and compassion. How often do we give love without judgment, conditions or strings attached to it?



COMPLANTING MOON (Deer)

In Native American Astrology, those born from May 21 - June 20th are born under the Complanting Moon and their animal totem is the Deer. Their colors are green and white and they are included in the Butterfly Elemental Clan.

If they learn to embrace them, Deer people possess natural healing abilities and are usually very intuitive. They have sensitive hearing and do not like loud noises. Deer are gentle, loving and kind animals. They often have the ability to create items of beauty from very ordinary objects. They are resourceful individuals. Deer people also make good friends. Deer is the epitome of both masculine and feminine energy and suggests their dual nature. SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:

Over the past year, many of you have written to me about your once beautiful relationship that has either ended suddenly or their partner departs then returns and departs again. Astrologically, the Saturn Neptune opposition has been illuminating our relationship needs and also exposing deception and blind spots within them. Everything seemed to be going along wonderfully then your partner suddenly "sabotages" or undermines it leaving you to understand why. Sometimes these dynamics, the quick departures, have been a pattern in past relationships. Breaks in a relationship are a self protection and a measure to reduce intimacy with who one loves. The mind is too divided and frightened to change and so it sticks to freedom. Fear of committing to any relationship triggers a stress reaction. One reason is that your partner has suffered some form of physical, emotional, psychological or sexual abuse in childhood with one or both parents or in a previous intimate relationship. If your partner grew up in an abusive or neglectful household, there is a good possibility the pattern will persist in your relationship with him or her.

Abuse takes many forms. Withholding love, attention, money or financial resources and sex is one form of abuse; abuse of control. Verbal and sexual abuses are other forms. Psychological/emotional abuse would include the distortion of your reality, projection, passive aggressive behavior, manipulation and then disassociation. These behaviors, often unconsciously motivated, tend to persist while the one being abused has difficulty in both recognizing and understanding the dynamics of why. Everything is wonderful, exciting and peaceful; then suddenly everything changes. The cycle of abuse tends to persist into adulthood until the individual first confronts, and then heals the past. Our early parental imprints, although deeply embedded, need to be exposed, healed and transformed in order to maintain a healthy relationship first with the self and then with others. "A person begins life with a particular perception of how things are between parents. That picture does not have to remain static. But a long as it is unconscious, it will not change, and then the individual becomes caught in a compulsive pattern which feels like fate." (Green & Sasporatas)

Another common reason relationships fail is that one or both partners do not take time to heal or to understand what went wrong in a past relationship. Becoming involved too quickly after another relationship has ended might feel good at the time yet it interrupts a critical step in letting go of the past and healing the heart after the end of a relationship loss. It is never only one person's "fault" for use of a better word, when a relationship ends. There are usually signs leading up to it as well that many ignore. Sometimes it's easier to not face the real issues and stay in denial. For some individuals ignorance is bliss and turning a blind cheek allows one to not deal with necessary change or the painful process of moving on. Letting go of a partner you love and care about yet who ultimate does not meet your long term wants and needs is a difficult decision to make. This is where knowing, beforehand, what you value and what is absolutely necessary for your growth comes into play. If you don't know what you want, need and soothes your soul, you certainly won't know it when it finds you and when it comes in another form you may turn it away. It is also about knowing what doesn't fit and work for you so as to avoid unnecessary selection errors in situations causing heartache.

When a relationship does finally end, it is important to understand why. So many people slap a band aid on their hearts and protect their egos by immediately becoming involved with a new partner. Statistically, rebound relationships don't usually work. They do not work for a variety of reasons. One of the most important reasons is not having the time to grieve the loss of the last partner and understand why. What was the lesson and why did I attract that individual into my life? Some relationships are not meant to last "forever". If betrayal was an issue there are all kinds of anger, guilt and resentful feelings attached to the loss. Unless you move through this step successfully, the unconscious pain will persist in the next relationship and will be triggered by the new partner, ultimately setting up the new relationship for failure. In addition, many people haven't healed abuse from their family or origin. If you haven't dealt with your family of origin issues, their beliefs about the type of partner you should have, whether or not you should have children, etc. these unconscious "scripts" will direct your behavior and ultimately sabotage the good things in your life. Dr. John Gray, the author famous for his book on Men are from Mars, Women are from Venus wrote something about this very topic. I'll copy some of it for you here.

New Discoveries - Getting Unstuck by John Gray PhD.

From my own discovery, I began to explore how my clients were blocking various negative emotions in their lives. Some were stuck feeling angry because they could not cry. Others cried easily, but could not get angry. As a result they become stuck in their grief. Fear and insecurity paralyzed others, because they had not taken enough time to feel their sadness or anger. Others were stuck in sorrow and unable to love, because they had not confronted their fears.

People were stuck in so many ways simply because their past conditioning prevented them from recognizing and feeling one or two of the four healing emotions. I discovered that every negative state was the direct result of an imbalance of negative emotions. With the correct balance, a healing release automatically took place. Negative feelings were automatically replaced by positive feelings of relief, peace, love, understanding, forgiveness and trust.

All negative states are the direct result of an imbalance of negative emotions.

This was a different way of looking at negative emotions. Prior to this realization, I thought negative emotions were the problem and not the solution. With this new insight, rather than encouraging my clients to try to get rid of negative emotions, or try to express them, I suggested that my clients expand their awareness of negative emotions to include all four healing emotions. As a result, particularly when they felt stuck in an emotion, shifting to another emotion would in almost all cases provide immediate relief. After working with thousands of clients and workshop participants, I was eventually able to forge and refine this new understanding of the four healing emotions.

Getting Stuck in Anger...

"If a person is not able to feel sadness, fear or sorrow, then it is easy to get stuck feeling angry. Due to social conditioning, men in particular have trouble admitting to feelings of sadness, fear and sorrow. It is more acceptable for a man to feel anger. This limitation causes men to play a heavy price. When they finally experience the other negative emotions, they are overwhelmed. It is as though all the hurt of a lifetime comes up. Though this is very difficult to handle, if a man is able to complete the grieving process, he will be free once and for all of all the conditioning that limits many men.

When either a man or a woman is unable to acknowledge and share his or her fear and sorrow, the ability to give and receive love will be restricted. If a man experiences a broken heart but is unable to acknowledge his more vulnerable emotions, he may become overly demanding, defensive, or indifferent in subsequent relationships. As soon as he begins to feel increasing love and intimacy, his unresolved feelings of sadness, fear and sorrow become activated.

To avoid having to deal with these unresolved feelings once again, his automatic tendency is to pull away. He will begin to feel powerless to get what he needs, become confused about his feelings, and question his commitment. Just as he suppressed these feelings before, he will do it again. Although he will feel justified, he will tend to become increasing demanding, defensive, and indifferent.

When a feeling is blocked in our past, until it is unblocked we will have difficulty fully feeling that level of emotion. In XXXX's adult years, he couldn't tolerate sadness and disappointment from his partners, because these feelings were still unresolved within him. As long as he was not willing to feel his own sadness and grief, he could not tolerate disappointment in his relationships. He would react defensively with anger and blame. By embracing his own feelings, he was gradually able to adjust his expectations and to understand his partner's need to feel upset at times. With this crucial adjustment, he was able to be less defensive and demanding of his partner.

If a man remembers a past relationship with blame, he may continue to get involved but when he is required to make normal sacrifices or compromises he is often quick to back out.

When we lose love, we may feel it is too painful to love again. To heal our broken heart, we must release our attachment and open ourselves to giving and receiving love with others. If we do not take the risk to open our heart again, we will either stay stuck in our pain or remain emotionally numb. The process of letting go of our attachment allows us to reset our heart and move on."

Our Heart is a muscle. When we do not use our muscles they atrophy. Anyone who works out at a gym or exercises knows that in order to keep and strengthen muscle tone, it needs to be worked out. In fact, each time a muscle is wasted (worked out until you can't anymore) it becomes stronger. Loving is risky business. Heart disease is on the rise in our country and it was once thought that men lead in the area of heart attacks. Heart disease is one of the leading causes of death in women. Women are less likely to survive a heart attack then men and researchers don't seem to understand why. Do you have a guess as to why?
