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**Happy Birthday Libra the Scales!** to all of those born between September 23 - October 22! Key Phrase for Libra is "**I BALANCE**"

The sign of Libra is ruled by lovely Venus and along with the 7<sup>th</sup> house rules relationships of all kinds, marriage, open enemies, law suits.

Libra also rules the kidneys. Librans usually have a great many interests ie: theater, decorating, beautiful music, art collecting...anything that is aesthetically pleasing and luxurious. Libra abhors discord and will literally run in the opposite direction to avoid anything or anyone distasteful or unpleasant. Libra Rising individuals usually have great legs!

Libra's polar opposite (7th house - partnerships, relationships, law suits, open enemies, marriage) is the cardinal, fire sign Aries (1st house- personality, self, physical appearance). The integration of me versus us is some areas of life for Libra, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite...the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Libra can become ...just like fiery Aries, ruled by war god Mars and lose their balance and become impulsive or impatient.

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**Tarot Card # 11 - Justice - Symbolic of Libra**

Justice represents harmony and balance. In all the cards, we encounter the positive and negatives aspects of life. We must always choose between right and wrong, dark and light

and find the shades of gray in between. Justice represents the balance that we must all create in order to live a healthy and fulfilling life.

The image in this card sits a woman between 2 columns. In her right hand she holds a double-edged swords, symbolic of the mind, duality and decision-making. In her left hand are the scales of justice used to find harmony and balance. There are often conflicting elements in our lives preventing us from achieving balance. When this card appears in a reading, it suggest that you must look at the areas of imbalance or excess in your life to where moderation and equilibrium will bring you peace and replace chaos.

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### THE DUCKS FLY MOON

In Native American Astrology, those born from September 23- October 22nd are born under the Ducks Fly Moon and are the **Raven** people. Their gemstone is Jasper or Bloodstone and has properties to actually stop hemorrhaging/bleeding and provide the owner with a long life. Raven people, when they have not found their balance, will fly from one mood to another. As we know, this kind of mood fluctuation can cause depression in some. Raven people who have found the balance in their lives can utilize their special psychic powers to help others find their own point of balance.

Raven people are also quite versatile and have the ability to shift and change. They are able to get over and smooth out discord in their surroundings and are adept in assisting others in the same. They are capable of making others feel soothed and welcome.

Raven people are very intelligent and are capable of soaring from one position to another rather quickly. These are people who are both comfortable on the earth and in the sky...on the material plane and spiritual plane. They do tend to be group oriented and enjoy the mutual support and cooperation from their group. Raven people often mate for life, however, some do not. They frequently find it difficult to make a decision about the relationship and will frequently change their mind about whether or not they have chosen the "right" partner. Harmony is very important to the Raven.

### JUNO - Relating - The Wife

Juno is the goddess of marriage and was known for her fidelity and loyalty to her husband Zeus/Jupiter. The 6<sup>th</sup> month of June was sacred to her and traditionally many marriages take place during the month of June. Juno symbolizes the principle of relationship and like the sign of Libra, our most intimate partnerships. She also signifies the consummation of marriage and is also linked to the sign of Scorpio. Children and the rights of children are linked to Juno in the horoscope.

Juno in your horoscope can point to a "soul" mate partner and is often an indicator of compatibility between two birth charts. Juno yearns for a deeply committed, mystical and sexually fulfilling relationship. Unfortunately many of Juno's expectations in her marriage

to Jupiter were not fulfilled and realized. Jupiter betrayed Juno by having numerous affairs while holding her loyal to him in her sexual chastity. He did not maintain sexual fidelity. Since her relationship needs were not met, she displayed a variety of complexes which included jealousy, abandonment issues, sacrifice, playing victim, giving away of power, manipulation, patterns of oppression, possessiveness and anger to name a few.

Juno wanted a relationship that was fair and reciprocal. However, what she experienced with Jupiter were power struggles, infidelity, oppression, disappointments and conflicts when she was faced with the reality of her marriage to Jupiter for what it really was.

Bringing the symbol of Juno in our relationship today is quite different. Having one monogamous relationship our entire life is no longer the norm, nor is it practical. We live so much longer and are more spiritually aware and growth oriented. It is more common for us to have serial monogamy where we may have 3 or 4 long-term partners or marriages during our life. I do not believe that most people are naturally monogamous, although I believe that planets in some signs are more prone towards monogamy, it is a choice some people make for themselves and their relationship. That choice is one of maintaining intimacy, security and stability within an existing relationship. Let's face it, the more distractions or people you bring into a marriage the greater likelihood for that marriage to break down over time anyway. Fear of committing or being truly "intimate" with a partner may also cause one or both to seek excitement outside of the marriage. Cyber affairs come to mind here.

Perhaps Juno had unrealistic expectations in her marriage to Jupiter/Jupiter/Zeus. She assumed that in marriage she would be Jupiter's only sexual partner. When she discovered this was not the case, she became enraged, jealous and very possessive of him. She remained faithful to him despite his infidelity. This was her choice. Her faithfulness was one of Juno's finest attributes. She stood by her man, no matter what. The unfortunate part of this was that her unhappiness and sadness was internalized. The sexual boundaries in their marriage were betrayed. When we internalize hurt and pain and feel unfulfilled a variety of pathologies can surface ie: resentment, regret and bitterness. She might have asked herself some questions: How much must I sacrifice to be in this marriage? When does the sacrifice to be in this marriage betray who I am and what I value most? Is my compromise appreciated? Astrologically, here Juno would signify the lack of acknowledgment received from her partner and the emerging resentment that her needs are not being met.

When we take a vow of marriage most people think their spouse automatically takes a vow of fidelity. How many people ask their partner, beforehand, if they want only one sexual partner during the marriage and more importantly can they be monogamous? Given the high incidence of "affairs" in our society, I think we need to discuss issues of fidelity "before" we legally tie the knot, don't you agree? It is mostly assumed that because you have a legal document, a marriage certificate, this implies fidelity and the marriage will be a monogamous relationship. In actuality, it only implies a legal commitment ("Til Divorce do us part.") and a tax deduction. Actually, in the vows of marriage there is nothing insinuating fidelity. "Love, Honor and Obey." (ahem) This sounds typical of something the patriarchal Roman Catholic Church would write, doesn't it? Obey?? Define "Obey". My interpretation is "Do as I say, not as I do".

Our patriarchal society imposes monogamy and restricts our basic, inherent instinct to procreate, at will. Monogamy and fidelity is a choice. It should never be assumed or taken for granted. Both celibacy and monogamy are choices you make and it is human nature and your basic right to be able to change your mind about it. Astrologer Jeffrey Green comments on this and states that the concept of monogamy, one sexual partner for life, exists because men wanted to own and possess their partners. The beginning of patriarchy has its roots in the knowledge that men have an "interest" in and contributed to the conception of children...this was the beginning of patriarchy. Their partners were then considered property to own. Is this why when women marry they suddenly becomes Mrs. "His last name"? These are issues surrounding the position of Juno in the birth chart.

The house in which Juno resides in your birth chart points to where you are most committed. For instance, Juno in the 10<sup>th</sup> house might show a person most committed to work and their profession. It might also say that having a "wife" or "husband" and having the identity of being "married" is important to the career. Juno conjunct (close in degree) the Sun would manifest similarly and might also say "I don't exist without a partner" or "I need to have a committed partner or I am committed to partnering". My own Juno resides in house 9 in the sign of Leo, the house of higher learning, beliefs, spirituality, philosophies and long distance travel. I have on more than one occasion been in a relationship with someone from another country, ethnicity or in relationship with a partner who traveled for work. I also need my partner to share in similar philosophies of life and a spiritual path. In the sign of Leo, I tend to be attracted to Fire signs (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius). Juno in Leo in the 9<sup>th</sup> house would show the need for a loyal and devoted partner, one to feel proud of (Leo). The other side of that is that I am a fiercely loyal (Leo) and fair and open-minded (9<sup>th</sup> house- Jupiter energy) partner in return.

Today, the placement of Juno in your chart may also symbolize the area of life where you should be open to change and balance in your relationship. If Juno lived in 2003 perhaps she would have divorced Jupiter. Perhaps she would not have accepted the back seat in their marriage. Women today want equal power in their relationships and don't necessarily see it their duty to stay and protect the home life if it means giving up parts of whom they are or how they want and need to be treated.

Juno is currently transiting at 21 degrees of Scorpio. Juno in the sign of Scorpio craves emotional and sexual intensity and may be possessive of their partner. There may be attempts to control the partner.

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**October 2003**

**October 8, 2003 - Mercury** Enters the sign of Libra - Flowing words of love, beautiful thoughts and ease of communication.

**October 10, 2003 - Venus enters Scorpio** - Venus in Scorpio is intense and passionate, suspicious and possessive.

**October 10, 2003 - Full Moon - 16 Aries 35** - A Full Moon is always about a culmination or bringing to a conclusion or a new awareness in the sign of Aries. Mars is the natural ruler of Aries and the moon and mars elevates emotions. Please watch your driving during this Full Moon in Mars ruled Aries. What area of life (house) does this Full Moon operate in your birth chart?

**October 23, 2003 - Sun enters Scorpio** - Happy Birthday Scorpio! The Sun wants to intensity in the passionate and secretive sign of Scorpio.

**October 23, 2003 Neptune stations direct at 10 Aquarius 24 is still moving backwards** and starts out the month at 11 degrees 04 of Aquarius. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

**October 25, 2003 - New Moon 1 Scorpio 41** - A New Moon in the sign of Scorpio may be symbolic of a need to transform the area of life (house) this moon fall in your birth chart.

**October 25, 2003 - Mercury enters Scorpio** - Mercury in Scorpio is precise and intense. The ability to get to the root of a problem increases while mercury resides in this sign.

**October 25, 2003 through March 7, 2004** - Saturn turns Retrograde at 13 Cancer 14 Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. In relationships, while Saturn is retrograde (backward motion) Saturn wants us to rethink and finish up any obligations or promises we have made that do not suit our purpose. If commitments made are no longer working then its time to set limits set boundaries about what we expect. If a relationship is not working, this is the time to let it go.

**October 31, 2003 - Happy Halloween!!**

**Jupiter stays in earthy Virgo.** Jupiter starts the month at 7 Virgo 20 and ends up at 12 Virgo 54. With Jupiter in Virgo, we may take a step back and be more discerning in our expansiveness. Our pleasures may be more reserved, tempered or serious. Jupiter in Virgo will be much more practical and realistic than when in the sign of Leo. All of the Virgos out there should be receiving some nice benefits with Jupiter in Virgo transiting your Sun.

**Uranus is still retrograde (rx) at 2 Pisces 49** - Uranus will stay rx until November 7, 2003 and go direct at 28 Aquarius 54. Uranus will back up into the sign of Aquarius on **September 16**. Any planet in his path will be affected by sudden shifts and change. Initially oppositions of 0-4 degrees of Virgo will be affected then 2-4 degrees of Gemini and Sagittarius (the squares). As Uranus moves into the sign of Aquarius, his opposite Leo will be greatly impacted as well as the squares of planets in 27, 28, 29 degrees Taurus and Scorpio.

**Pluto starts the month at 17 Sagittarius 31' and ends the month at 18 Sagittarius 15**. Whatever Pluto touches in your chart will leave an imprint in your psyche. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul!

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**SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. The symbols were later revised by Dane Rudhyar and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. One of my favorite modern interpretations is written by Lynda Hill. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

**FULL MOON October 10, 2003 - 16 Aries 35**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the October 10<sup>th</sup> Full Moon falls in the sign of Aries, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Aries is a cardinal, fire sign and resides in the 1st house of the zodiac, ruled by the god of war, Mars. Issues involving yourself and assertiveness, How others see you, anger and impatience are all highlighted during this Full Moon. Your energy level will feel more active during this time.

**SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 17 Aries:**

**TWO PRIM SPINSTERS SITTING TOGETHER IN SILENCE**

This symbol seems to imply people who know each other a long time. They are able to sit together without too many words and understand each other on a deep level. Perhaps they have grown up together and there is no need for constant talk. They are companions to each other. They are prim, so perhaps too conservative. Maybe they would like to discuss

issues that have been repressed for years or because of their upbringing feel they cannot. Anything we repress eventually gets distorted under the surface. Eventually it can break up a companionship. Words left unspoken can often do harm. If we pretend to be someone we are, not speak our truth and be true to ourselves, we can shut down.

### **NEW MOON October 25, 2003 - 1 Scorpio 41**

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Scorpio rules the 8th house, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be finances, sexual issues, value systems of those you are involved with, tax issues, inheritances and investments and psychotherapy...self-analysis.

### **SABIAN SYMBOL for 2 Scorpio:**

### **SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:**

I always need extend a special thank you to everyone who has written to me after reading the September issue of Lunar Notes. I especially thank everyone who has submitted birth data and their personal stories to me on the special Indigo child in their life.

Since we have entered the relationship sign of Libra, I thought it would be a good idea to discuss partnerships. If you just started dating that special person or if you have been in a partnership that you are uncertain about, perhaps you need to write your "list" of things most important to you not only in a partner, but to you personally and on your life path.

When I became divorced, it was important for me to formulate such a list not only for myself but also for deciding if a prospective partner is right for me. If you know what you want and need for yourself in a relationship beforehand then you will not get sidetrack or off track once you've become emotionally attached. Or perhaps you will spare yourself some heartache from emotional attachment if the person doesn't match your "Wish List". The list is as follows:

### **My Wish List**

#### **My SQN sine qua non (without which not) the thing without which the relationship would NOT exist.**

Here, you should write the one absolute you must have and if not for this one thing..the relationship would not exist. For instance, for me, if my partner was not my best friend and there is little or no intimacy, the relationship would not exist.

#### **Prefer to Have (very important needs - some are negotiable and some non-negotiable)**

Not in any particular order - I'll give a few examples and you can write as many as you like..these can be partially negotiable while others may not.

- Good Communication - Problem solver
- Honesty
- High Self-Esteem
- Spiritual connection - path
- Feel emotionally safe/secure with this person
- Trust - critical
- Healthy or health conscious
- Must have similar morals and values - respect for me and others
- Works hard and perseveres
- Cleanliness
- Non-Smoker, no drugs, prefer non-drinker
- Sense of Humor
- Generous with time, self, possessions, love
- Appreciation of me and shows with actions
- Polite, good manners

**Just for fun (but still important):** These are really just for fun...if the fairy godmother said you could have this too

- Person has an understanding of what it takes to make a relationship work and is willing to work on it even when problems surface.
- Financially secure

She then asks you to write a list of what are the 5 most important things in your life:

What is the most important thing in your life? List 5 items or more:

1. Family - Being in a loving, mutually supportive relationship
2. Spirituality/Learning/Personal Growth/My Curiosity/Sense of Accomplishment
3. Healthy/Active lifestyle
4. Friends
5. Independence and creativity

After that write a list of your deepest values. The deepest values are what you are willing to stake your life on, not in any particular order.

What am I willing to stake my life on - My deepest values:

1. Honesty
2. Integrity
3. Loyalty
4. Passion
5. Helping Others
6. Relationship

What is your life purpose? Have you ever given this any thought? Why do you feel you are here? Do you have something you are compelled to complete in this lifetime?

What is your specific purpose in life?

1. To Teach/Counsel/Guide Others/Study ie: Spiritual path
2. To Create
3. To Give Love
4. To Understand
5. To Parent
6. To Guide
7. To Organize

After you write these lists, have your partner write his. How do they match your ideal partner? Will your relationship meet your long-term needs and goals? Do your life purposes coincide or are you moving in different life directions? These are important questions to ask yourself.

In addition to these, in a past relationship we did another really nice exercise..actually it was a lot of fun. It goes like this:

Write another list to share with your partner called: **Why I Am Not Such a Bargain!!**

You might write something like "I keep the toothpaste cap off the toothpaste" or I have a habit of doing....

Then you can share another list called: **Why I Am So Terrific!!**

In this list you get to brag a little so have some fun!

This works pretty well if you have already started to date a person or have already been for awhile. It is also a lot of fun to share with friends. I wrote my list and sent it to a long-term male friend awhile back. We had known each other for several years and I wanted to see if he saw me as I saw myself. He read both lists and actually added to my terrific column and deleted from my not such a bargain column. I liked that!! Of course he gave me a detailed explanation why he changed what he did. The point I'm trying to make is that we do not always see our attributes and faults as others do. It's always important for others to validate our experiences and us.
