Happy Birthday Libra the Scales! to those born between September 23 - October 22! Key Phrase for Libra is "I BALANCE" The sign of Libra is ruled by lovely Venus and along with the  $7^{th}$  house rules relationships of all kinds, marriage, open enemies, law suits.

Libra also rules the kidneys, and veins. Librans usually have a great many interests ie: theater, decorating, beautiful music, art collecting...anything that is aesthetically pleasing and luxurious. Libra abhors discord and will literally run in the opposite direction to avoid anything or anyone distasteful or unpleasant. They are people who try to smooth over difficult situations and will "mediate" the atmosphere around them. Libra Rising (ascendant) individuals are often visually attractive, charming and usually have great legs!

Libra folks want their relationships to be fair and in balance. Often enough, the task is working at maintaining balance rather than being "in balance" naturally. Libra is the only sign of the zodiac that is a mechanical device rather than an animal or human figure.

"The scales in Libra had a deep significance for the Egyptians. It was said that at the time of death the goddess Maat placed the human soul on one scale and a feather on the other. If the scale tipped even slightly, the soul must reincarnate with the goal of releasing the extra weight. Since Libra comes before Scorpio, the sign associated with death - which the Egyptians honored in the eloquent preparations for the afterlife - the prime goal in life was to make the scales balance, or to prepare the soul for its afterlife" - Mythic Astrology, Guttman and Johnson.

Libra's polar opposite (7th house - partnerships, relationships, law suits, open enemies, marriage) is the cardinal, fire sign Aries (1st house- personality, self, physical appearance). The integration of me versus us is some areas of life for Libra, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite....the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Libra can become ...just like fiery Aries, ruled by war god Mars and loose their balance and become impulsive or impatient.

## Tarot Card # 11 - Justice - Symbolic of Libra

Justice represents harmony and balance. In all the cards, we encounter the positive and negatives aspects of life. We must always choose between right and wrong, dark and light and find the shades of gray in between. Justice represents the balance that we must all create in order to live a healthy and fulfilling life.

The image in this card sits a woman between 2 columns. In her right hand she holds a double-edged sword, symbolic of the mind, duality and decision-making. In her left hand are the scales of justice used to find harmony and balance. There are often conflicting

elements in our lives preventing us from achieving balance. When this card appears in a reading, it suggest that you must look at the areas of imbalance or excess in your life to where moderation and equilibrium will bring you peace and replace chaos.

#### THE DUCKS FLY MOON

In Native American Astrology, those born from September 23- October 22nd are born under the Ducks Fly Moon and are the **Raven** people. Their gemstone is Jasper or Bloodstone and has properties to actually stop hemorrhaging/bleeding and provide the owner with a long life. Raven people, when they have not found their balance, will fly from one mood to another. As we know, this kind of mood fluctuation can cause depression in some. Raven people who have found the balance in their lives can utilize their special psychic powers to help others find their own point of balance.

Raven people are also quite versatile and have the ability to shift and change. They are able to get over and smooth out discord in their surroundings and are adept in assisting others in the same. They are capable of making others feel soothed and welcome.

Raven people are very intelligent and are capable of soaring from one position to another rather quickly. These are people who are both comfortable on the earth and in the sky...on the material plane and spiritual plane. They do tend to be group oriented and enjoy the mutual support and cooperation from their group. Raven people often mate for life, however, some do not. They frequently find it difficult to make a decision about the relationship and will frequently change their mind about whether or not they have chosen the "right" partner. Harmony is very important to the Raven.

## JUNO - Relating - The Wife (partial reprint from Oct 2003 Lunar notes)

Juno is the goddess of marriage and was known for her fidelity and loyalty to her husband Zeus/Jupiter. The 6<sup>th</sup> month of June was sacred to her and traditionally many marriages take place during the month of June. Juno symbolizes the principle of relationship and like the sign of Libra, our most intimate partnerships. She also signifies the consummation of marriage and is also linked to the sign of Scorpio. Children and the rights of children are linked to Juno in the horoscope.

Juno in your horoscope can point to a "soul" mate partner and is often an indicator of compatibility between two birth charts. Juno yearns for a deeply committed, mystical and sexually fulfilling relationship. Unfortunately many of Juno's expectations in her marriage to Jupiter were not fulfilled and realized. Jupiter betrayed Juno by having numerous affairs while holding her loyal to him in her sexual chastity. He did not maintain sexual fidelity. Since her relationship needs were not met, she displayed a variety of complexes which included jealousy, abandonment issues, sacrifice, playing victim, giving away of power, manipulation, patterns of oppression, possessiveness and anger to name a few.

Juno wanted a relationship that was fair and reciprocal. However, what she experienced with Jupiter were power struggles, infidelity, oppression, disappointments and conflicts when she was faced with the reality of her marriage to Jupiter for what it really was.

Bringing the symbol of Juno in our relationship today is quite different. Having one monogamous relationship our entire life is no longer the norm, nor is it practical. We live so much longer and are more spiritually aware and growth oriented. It is more common for us to engage in serial monogamy where we may have 3 or 4 long-term partners or marriages during our life. I do not believe that most people are naturally monogamous, although I believe that planets in some signs are more prone towards monogamy, it is a choice some people make for themselves and their relationship. That choice is one of maintaining intimacy, security and stability within an existing relationship. Let's face it, the more distractions or people you bring into a marriage the greater likelihood for that marriage to break down over time anyway. Fear of committing or being truly "intimate" with a partner may also cause one or both to seek excitement outside of the marriage. Cyber affairs come to mind here.

Perhaps Juno had unrealistic expectations in her marriage to Jupiter/Zeus. She assumed that in marriage she would be Jupiter's only sexual partner. When she discovered this was not the case, she became enraged, jealous and very possessive of him. She remained faithful to him despite his infidelity. This was her choice. Her faithfulness was one of Juno's finest attributes. She stood by her man, no matter what. The unfortunate part of this was that her unhappiness and sadness was internalized. The sexual boundaries in their marriage were betrayed. When we internalize hurt and pain and feel unfulfilled a variety of pathologies can surface ie: resentment, regret and bitterness. She might have asked herself some questions: How much must I sacrifice to be in this marriage? When does the sacrifice to be in this marriage betray who I am and what I value most? Is my compromise appreciated? Astrologically, here Juno would signify the lack of acknowledgment received from her partner and the emerging resentment that her needs are not being met.

When we take a vow of marriage most people think their spouse automatically takes a vow of fidelity. How many people ask their partner, beforehand, if they want only one sexual partner during the marriage and more importantly can they be monogamous? Given the high incidence of "affairs" in our society, I think we need to discuss issues of fidelity "before" we legally tie the knot, don't you agree? It is mostly assumed that because you have a legal document, a marriage certificate, this implies fidelity and the marriage will be a monogamous relationship. In actuality, it only implies a legal commitment ("Til Divorce do us part.") and a tax deduction. Actually, in the vows of marriage there is nothing insinuating fidelity. "Love, Honor and Obey." (ahem) This sounds typical of something the patriarchal Roman Catholic Church would write, doesn't it? Obey?? Define "Obey". My interpretation is "Do as I say, not as I do".

Our patriarchal society imposes and assumes monogamy and restricts our basic, inherent instinct to procreate, at will. Monogamy and fidelity is a choice. It should never be assumed or taken for granted. Both celibacy and monogamy are choices you make and it is human nature and your basic right to be able to change your mind about it. Astrologer

Jeffrey Green comments on this and states that the concept of monogamy, one sexual partner for life, exists because men wanted to own and possess their partners. The beginning of patriarchy has its roots in the knowledge that men have an "interest" in and contributed to the conception of children...this was the beginning of patriarchy. Their partners were then considered property to own. Is this why when women marry they suddenly becomes Mrs. "His last name"? These are issues surrounding the position of Juno in the birth chart.

The house in which Juno resides in your birth chart points to where you are most committed. For instance, Juno in the  $10^{th}$  house might show a person most committed to work and their profession. It might also say that having a "wife" or "husband" and having the identity of being "married" is important to the career. Juno conjunct (close in degree) the Sun would manifest similarly and might also say "I don't exist without a partner" or "I need to have a committed partner or I am committed to partnering". My own Juno resides in house 9 in the sign of Leo, the house of higher learning, beliefs, spirituality, philosophies and long distance travel. I have on more than one occasion been in a relationship with someone from another country, ethnicity or in relationship with a partner who traveled for work. I also need my partner to share in similar philosophies of life and a spiritual path. In the sign of Leo, I tend to be attracted to Fire signs (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius). Juno in Leo in the  $9^{th}$  house would show the need for a loyal and devoted partner, one to feel proud of (Leo). The other side of that is that I am a fiercely loyal (Leo) and fair and open-minded  $(9^{th}$  house- Jupiter energy) partner in return.

Today, the placement of Juno in your chart may also symbolize the area of life where you should be open to change and balance in your relationship. If Juno lived in 2004 perhaps she would have divorced Jupiter. Perhaps she would not have accepted the back seat in their marriage. Women today want equal power in their relationships and don't necessarily see it their duty to stay and protect the home life if it means giving up parts of who they are or how they want and need to be treated.

Juno is currently transiting at 12 degrees of Capricorn. Juno in the sign of Capricorn desires stability and a partner who has a good public reputation and a successful career. The ideal partner is usually conservative and somewhat reserved. If your Juno is in the sign of Capricorn you may find it difficult to display your emotions yet when you commit you are loyal and security-minded. You seek lasting unions and will, therefore, probably marry later in life.

October, 2004

Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 \_ days.

October 1, 2004 - Mars continues in Venus ruled Libra. - Mars begins the month at 2 Libra 58' and will end the month at 22 Libra 34. He will conjunct our Solar Eclipse degree (21 Libra). Mars in Venus ruled Libra, is more loving and desiring of relationship and balance.

October 1, 2004 - Jupiter starts the month at 1 Libra 15' - Jupiter in Libra is expansive in love matters. Jupiter is conjunct Mars right now and is assertive and energetic.

October 3, 2004 - Venus enters earthy Virgo. Venus in Virgo is particular in love. We seek a relationship that will serve us in practical ways. Sensuality is heightened and we are more aware of nuances within our intimate relationships. Adopting a pet or caring for our health, incorporating a new health regime is possible now.

October 14, 2004: New Moon 21 Libra 06'. (Solar Eclipse) A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. In Libra, ruled by lovely Venus, is the 7th sign of the zodiac. You may want to focus on your most intimate relationships, including marriage and commitment. Legal issues and contracts can be worked on during this time. Acquiring object of beauty or beautifying your home is another possibility.

October 16, 2004 – Mercury enters 00 Scorpio. Communications are intense in the sign of Scorpio. The ability to research and delve into the psyche and psychotherapy of all kinds is highlighted. This is a good time self exploration and for personal growth.

October 24, 2004: Sun enters Scorpio - Happy Birthday Scorpio! Scorpio is a feminine, fixed (stable) and water (emotions) sign. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Scorpio in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

October 28, 2004 – Full Moon 05 Taurus 02' – Lunar Eclipse A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Taurus the focus is on security, what we value, how we earn income and our personal property

October 24, 2004 Neptune Direct at 12 Aquarius 36.' Neptune continued her retrograde beginning the month at 12 Aquarius 45 - If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed. Neptune ends at 12 Aquarius 46'. Now direct, expect some shattered illusions, deception revealed and the meaning of those recurring dreams you have been having illuminated.

Uranus in Pisces retrograde (rx) - Uranus starts the month at 03 Pisces 33 and will end the month at 02 Pisces 55'. With Uranus retrograde, we will internalize our Uranian energy. The focus may be on an area of study we need to work on for our self improvement. We may feel more self-contained. Planets in Virgo are in opposition to Uranus in Pisces and there may be a reevaluation of your health needs or being of service to others may surface (Virgo).

Saturn continues in Cancer - Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 26 Cancer 01'. He is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn is about to make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. He ends the month at 27 Cancer 16.

Pluto starts the month at 19 Sagittarius 48 and ends up at 20 Sagittarius 30' on the 31<sup>st</sup>. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing.

#### SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

## NEW MOON October 14, 2004 - 21 Libra 06' (Solar Eclipse)

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon. Because this is also a New Moon Solar Eclipse, outward events will present

themselves to you. In Libra, a new relationship or the redefining of a past relationship may be your focus of attention.

Since Libra rules the 7th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be your relationships, partners, marriage, contracts and even open enemies.

#### SABIAN SYMBOL for 22 LIBRA:

#### A CHILD GIVING BIRDS A DRINK AT A FOUNTAIN

This image reminds is one of innocence, sharing, caring and the flow of energy. Birds are spiritual messengers with something to share with us. Children are open minded and non judgmental and willing to listen to messages from the environment and nature. Water symbolizes emotions and intuition. This image speaks of being open to the messages we receive from the universe, from out of nowhere and being able to connect with the childlike qualities we all possess.

## FULL MOON - October 28, 2004 - 05 Taurus 02' (Lunar Eclipse)

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Since the October 28<sup>th</sup> Full Moon falls in the sign of Taurus, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Taurus is a fixed, earth sign and resides in the 2nd house of the natural zodiac, ruled by Venus. Venus is one of the two planets who rules two signs, both Taurus and Libra. Mercury is the other dual ruler of both Gemini and Virgo. Seeking security, developing your talents, money issues and work all fall under the domain of Taurus and the 2<sup>nd</sup> house. These issues may come into focus for you now.

Because this is no ordinary Full Moon, it is also a Lunar Eclipse, your focus may turn inward. Full Moon Total Lunar Eclipse is a culmination of events so anyone who has been undecided about a relationship issue may suddenly come to a decision or realization about its direction. Because this is a Lunar Eclipse, the emphasis will be on our instinctual "emotional" reactions, emotional makeup and emotions from our past; deeply hidden emotions and feelings passed down from our parentage, the mother more specifically. In Taurus, security and earnings may be the focus. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the culminating affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

#### SABIAN SYMBOL for 6 TAURUS:

#### A BRIDGE BEING BUILT ACROSS A HIGH NARROW GORGE

Bridges assist and connect us to "the other side". Bridging the gap and linking people and ideas comes to mind. Overcoming distance and separation is highlighted. The gorge is a barrier and might be water filled. Perhaps an emotional gap needs to be filled and physical

limitations are to be overcome. Building a bridge takes meticulous planning and can take a long time. The time spent will be well worth the wait.

Where does 6 Taurus (conjunction) or 6 Scorpio (opposition) or 6 Leo/Aquarius (square) fall in your chart?

#### Relationship Needs - Other Oriented versus Self Oriented

The astrological chart is like a pizza pie with 12 cut slices. If we cut the pie/chart in the center from left (East) to right (West) we would form the Ascendant/Descendant relationship axis. The East is our personal needs and the West would be the needs of the relationship or partner. When we cut the chart from bottom, North, center (IC) to the top, South, center (MC) we form the  $4^{th}$  house/ $10^{th}$  house axis of home versus work and private

versus public needs. Divisions of the chart hemispheres as indicated above assists in determining whether you are more "relationship" oriented or more "self" oriented. Planets located in the Western portion of the chart are relationship and "other" oriented. These are the signs of Cancer, Leo, Virgo, Libra, Scorpio and Sagittarius. Planets located in the Eastern hemisphere of the chart are more "Self" oriented. These signs are (Capricorn, Aquarius, Pisces, Aries, Taurus and Gemini. It is ideal to have a balance of planets in both hemispheres as this indicates a healthy approach to relationships and meeting not only your own needs, but the needs of your partner.

When the majority of planets reside in the Western hemisphere, this person might not have enough self confidence to take a stand in a relationship. Co-dependency is set up where the needs of the partner take precedence over the need to take care of the self when it may be inappropriate to care for the other. Having a majority of planets in the Western hemisphere may feel more insecure and lack confidence in relating, always considering the other first, again, even when it is detrimental to yourself to do so. This person may become overly involved in the lives of others leaving no room left for them selves. This could also be the person that everyone asks favors of, is taken advantage of and who doesn't know how to say "no" because of the need to feel needed.

However, if those planets are mostly in the masculine planets of fire and air, this can produce extreme impatience when the personal needs are thwarted or not immediately gratified. This person could be demanding or selfish or unrealistic about what to expect from others.

Having the majority of planets in the Eastern hemisphere would show a person who is overly independent. These people are so interested in having their own needs met they may not even be aware that their partners needs are not being met by them. It is so important to be able to tell the person we love and are involved with how we feel about them and know they are genuinely concerned about us. When there are hemisphere imbalances between a two people, this may be a source of conflict.

Eastern hemisphere people rarely turn to others for help. There is a level of pride in their independence. It can be very difficult to achieve true emotional intimacy with a person who has an overwhelming number of planets in the East. Knowing which hemisphere your partner's planets are located will provide relating clues.
