**THIS PAST YEAR OF YEAR 2004 = 2 + 0 + 0 + 4 = 6 - LOVERS CARD**

The energy of a # 6 year was about compassion, acceptance, responsibility and being of service. There was a deepening concern for family and home in this past year. Romance and the need for a partner, family and friends were also important. In the tarot deck, the 6<sup>th</sup> card is The Lovers card. The Lovers depicts the unclothed bodies of two lovers, a man and a woman. They bare their souls' to each other. The man gazes upon the woman while the woman looks up to the spirit, Archangel. As the angel hovers over the couple, arms and wings spread as if blessing the pair. The sun shines above his head, bringing warmth and security and light. The leaves on the tree mirror the hair on the Angels head...a symbol of the fires of passion burning deep within the lovers' soul. This sun and fire is also symbolic of our life force and our impulse to create. The fertile grass beneath their feet, and fruit on the tree suggests growth and happiness. This is a card of both moral and ethical choices and staying

true to your life path. If we did not stay true to your path, this year, a number 7 Year will provide focus and direction.

### **NUMEROLOGY FOR YEAR 2005 - A Number Seven Year (2+0+0+5 = 7) - THE CHARIOT in the Tarot**

According to Joan Bunning, "The Chariot, Card 7 represents the victories that are possible through willpower and self-mastery. A military image is appropriate for the Chariot because this card stands for the strengths associated with combat - discipline, grit, determination and assertiveness.

The Chariot represents the positive aspects of the ego. A healthy ego is one that is strong and self-assured. It knows what it wants and how to get it. We can get annoyed at someone whose ego is *too* healthy, but we often turn to that person to lead us through difficult moments. We know he or she won't be wishy-washy.

In readings, the Chariot often appears when hard control is or could be in evidence. At its best, hard control is not brutal, but firm and direct. It is backed up by a strong will and great confidence. The Chariot can mean self-control or control of the environment. This card also represents victory. There are many types of wins; the Chariot's is of the win-lose type. Your success comes from beating the competition to become number one. Such moments are glorious in the right circumstances."

In a number 7 Year, you can find creative solutions to past problems. This is a good year to reflect on the past and plan for the future. If you are determined to succeed you will. Your intuition is especially strong and you are self directed, not easily swayed. A 7 year promises to be an introspective year, gaining new understanding of yourself. When you focus on intent, you can make things happen. By moving beyond what you know, you act courageously on your behalf with much success.

This year, transiting Saturn (tradition, boundaries, karma, patriarchy) retrogrades in the sign of lunar ruled Cancer. Saturn is the natural ruler of Capricorn, the polar opposite of Cancer. This Cancer/Capricorn polarity embodies the theme of patriarchy versus matriarchy and the structures and foundations in your life. Also during this year we had the unconventional, erratic and unpredictable energy of Uranus in Pisces. For the last 7 years Uranus transited Aquarius revolutionized the way we communicate via the Internet. Uranus tends to speed up and quicken or irritate those planets into action that it touches by transit.

### **URANUS IN PISCES THEN INTO ARIES**

The erratic, unpredictable planet of revolution, change, electricity, the Internet, Astrologers, iconoclast Uranus, entered the mutable, water sign Pisces on December 31, 2003 and will stay in Pisces until May 27, 2010 at which time it will enter 0 Aries.

Uranus is all about change, whether you like it or want it or not. The form of change is unpredictable and erratic. Compassion and sympathy for the underdog is possible. Unique water purification systems are likely to be developed especially given the recent Earthquakes and treacherous Tsunami. Issues concerning the quality of our waters/oceans and sea life will be emphasized with Uranus in Pisces. Planets in Virgo are in opposition to Uranus in Pisces and there may be new health issues (Virgo) that surface in relationship to our drinking water (Pisces) or immune system.

However, Uranus will not stay in Aries and will retrograde backwards into the sign of Pisces on August 15, 2010. It will not return to the sign of Aries until March 13, 2011. It's interesting to me that Uranus entered compassionate Pisces in 2004 in a #6 year, The Lovers card. Now we enter a #7 Year, the year of the Chariot, symbolic of lunar ruled Cancer!

Saturn (Karma) now transiting backwards in the sign of Cancer and the Eclipses in the signs of Capricorn and Cancer in 2000/2001/2002 has already triggered and set that theme of change into motion. The recent Cancer/Capricorn Full Moon on December 26<sup>th</sup>, in close degree to the Full Moon Lunar Eclipse on June 24, 2002, coupled with transiting Chiron in Capricorn (wounds, healing, abandonment, reversals) opposed Saturn in Cancer on the day of the earthquake. The transiting Aries/Libra Nodes formed a cardinal grand cross with Chiron/Saturn. A tremendous amount of repressed energy released from the earth that caused much pain for those residing in Asia. Something had to give...and our Earth Mother is deeply distressed over her ill treatment.

**I'd like to send a message to our Mr. President to please pull our troops out of Iraq and send them to Asia where their assistance is needed more. We need a global effort to repair some of the devastation to the people, land and waters there MORE than we need to fight a senseless war of our own making.**

Happy Birthday Capricorn the Sea Goat! Happy Birthday to all of those born from December 22 - January 21! Key Phrase for Capricorn is **"I UTILIZE "**

Capricorn is a Cardinal (action oriented, initiator), earth (pragmatic and grounded) sign located in the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Capricorn governs the 10th house of the natural zodiac. Capricorns are considered the workaholics of the zodiac and Saturn expects nothing less from us than he is willing to do himself. Capricorns are dutiful, reliable and

steady. Many Capricorns were the children who everyone would seek advice. Many Capricorns were old before their time, wise beyond their years and very mature. They tend to act younger with each passing year wanting to make up for all that lost time! Capricorn in health issues relates to the skin, bones/skeletal system, knees and arthritis...illnesses where inflexibility or rigidity settles in the body.

Your ruling planet is the restrictive and structured planet Saturn. In traditional astrology, Saturn is considered to be a malefic planet and tends to operate through our fear. Saturn is considered to be thrifty, tactful, disciplined, stern, cold and severe. When Saturn transits our chart he usually brings some kind of limitation to our lives. Frustration and hard work is expected from Saturn. If you have met the challenge and worked through a Saturn transit, you will often manifest wisdom and benefits from your hard work. Sometimes when Saturn transits your chart decisions are made or finalized. On the positive side when you are self-disciplined and self-directed at a task, accomplishment and financial gain is your "Saturnian" reward. If you have Saturn strong in your chart, you may be drawn to antiques, ruins, ancient times and even collecting old objects of substance and worth.

Saturn and the sign of Capricorn reside in the 10th house of the zodiac and starts at the cusp called the MC or Medium Coeli. The 10th house is typically linked to structures, real estate, your public reputation and work in society, timing, cycles and wisdom earned as a result of difficult tasks. The 10th house, the ruler of the 10th and planets in the 10th are also symbolic of the mother, traditionally, or the parent who was most influential in your life. Saturn is a tough teacher and taskmaster, if you will. He sets limits, boundaries and obstacles for us to overcome. Depending on how well we do, he may grant us a "reward"...a reward for our hard work. In Karmic Astrology, Saturn plays an important role and represents cycles of time. When we are in a "karmic" relationship, there is a feeling of lack of control over the events and circumstances within the relationship. Through these circumstances and events, we develop a new self-awareness, a new understanding of the person we are involved with and also how we relate to the environment. Saturn will often present us with someone approximately 7, 14, 21 years older or younger than ourselves. "When the student is ready, the teacher (Saturn) will appear." Some karmic relationships are teacher/student, parent/child or counselor/patient. There is something, which must be taught, and something that needs to be learned and understood...by both participants. When there are Saturn contacts in synastry (chart comparison) it will usually augur a lasting and binding relationship.

Martin Schulman, in his wonderful Karmic Astrology series states: "Every time our unconscious is working something out, it calls into our lives the people who have within the pieces of the answer we are seeking." What he means is that you may find that a certain type of person or situation repeatedly enters your life. Just as you end a relationship with one person with a particular problem, another enters your life, often disguised, with a similar problem! (that is if you haven't worked through the last difficulties) Or...you may meet several people consecutively with the same sun or moon sign or similar aspects. There is something the universe is pointing you towards and you must pay attention to what is being presented for you to learn. This is Saturn - the wise teacher and why others often consult Capricorn's for their cut to the chase advice.

Capricorn's polar opposite (10th house - public reputation, real estate, business affairs, power, credit, profession and the Mother) is the cardinal, water sign Cancer (4th house - home, family, children, early childhood). Career versus home life, working and family are issues that are frequently in conflict for Capricorns, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite, the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Capricorn can become ...just like cardinal, watery Cancer, ruled by the Moon and become emotionally distraught and withdrawn crawling into its shell for self-nurturing and comfort.

When Saturn transits your birth chart or if Saturn is prominent in your chart, you may experience restrictions, boundary issues, and extra responsibilities.

Tarot Card # 15 XV - The Devil - Symbolic of Capricorn

The Devil Card in the Rider Waite Tarot deck is symbolic of some of the feelings we have when in an addictive relationship. We may feel so completely bonded to this person in an almost obsessive way. Because of this obsession we will often feel tied down or stifled by the intensity of this energy almost as if it is against our will! We often merge with this person on a very deep level losing our independence and allowing ourselves to be controlled and enslaved to this addictive feeling of sexual love. When we become addictive in our love patterns we often get caught up in appearances and the physical part of the relationship. We begin to limit ourselves, choosing to stay in the dark about other areas of the relationship. When we neglect seeing other areas of the relationship we can start to think negatively about seeing the relationship without this passionate energy and the intensity of the connection. We can become stuck in fear and doubt at this point.

On a mundane level, The Devil symbolizes our obsession with materialism. You may feel bound, controlled and owned by the possessions you have acquired, fearful of not having enough. We "are" what we own or without those "things" we are no one. Possessions and what we own only reflect our own inner insecurities, if that is all that brings us happiness. This doesn't always have to be a physical object as it can be a thought or a belief that keeps you stuck or self confined in self-destructive patterns, preventing of self-sabotaging your happiness.

The Symbol of The Devil may appear in a reading during a time when it's time to focus on ridding your obsessions over people, situations and material possessions that controls your life.

EARTH RENEWAL MOON (Snow Goose)

In Native American Astrology, those born from December 22nd - January 19th are born under the Earth Renewal Moon and their animal totem is the Snow Goose. Their color is white and quartz is their totem in the mineral kingdom. Quartz is a fairly hard mineral and comes in a variety of smoky pastel colors. Quartz is a power stone and has the ability to transmit and receive energy through it. Like the quartz, the Snow Goose has the ability to transmit and receive great powers to and from the universe. They have the ability to see clearly as long as they do not become too hard in their views or philosophies.

If you have ever seen Snow Geese flying overhead, you will see them fly in a V shape with an adult female as the lead goose. Each goose helps to break the air by those who follow. They make quite an impression on us with their "honking" and precision in flight. Snow Geese are also known to be nitpickers because they hate when things are left undone.

### **January, 2005**

**January 1, 2005 - HAPPY NEW YEAR! This is a perfect time to send healing energy to the Earth and the earthquake/tsunami survivors.**

**Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 \_ days.**

**January 10, 2005: New Moon 20 Capricorn 21'.** A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. Capricorn, ruled by Saturn, is the 10<sup>th</sup> sign of the zodiac. This is a positive time to work on real estate transactions, career and your public image. You may wish to focus on business affairs, your credit and your profession. Attention to knees and skin.

**January 10, 2005 - Mercury enters earthy Capricorn.** Mercury in cardinal Capricorn is pragmatic and resourceful. **On January 30<sup>th</sup> into Aquarius.** - original and inventive thought and communications are highlighted.

**January 10, 2005 - Venus enters Capricorn** - Venus in Capricorn is practical in love and chooses a partner who brings value to the relationship. Strong work ethic is indicative of this placement.

**January 20, 2005: Sun enters Aquarius** - Happy Birthday Aquarius! Aquarius is a fixed (tenacious) and air (thought) sign. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Aquarius in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

**January 25, 2005 - Full Moon 05 Leo 34'** - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Leo the focus is on your children, romance and matters of the heart as well as creative expression.

**Mars stays in fun loving Sagittarius** - Mars began the month at 4 Sagittarius and will end the month at 25 Sagittarius 34' Mars in Sagittarius wants freedom to romp and roam. The love of sport and intellectual debate is prominent.

**Jupiter** - Jupiter starts the month at 17 Libra 20' and ends the month at 18 Libra 51'. In the Venus ruled sign of Libra, Jupiter is expansive, loving and warm in love matters. Relationships are highlighted while Jupiter transits Libra.

**Saturn in Cancer continues his retrograde (rx) through March 22, 2005** - Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 25 Cancer 53'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. When retrograde we have the opportunity to finish or renegotiate projects we have started. He ends the month at 22 Cancer 28'. Whatever needs to be redone, reevaluated and reworked will be the focus during Saturn's retreat.

**Uranus in Pisces** - Uranus starts the month at 03 Pisces 56' and will end the month at 05 Pisces 21'. For instance, when Uranus transits opposite natal Venus, you may encounter a new love or the break up of an existing relationship. If you have a daughter, she may prove more rebellious or in need of freedom. If Uranus is transiting opposite natal Mercury, you may feel more restless and not need as much sleep. You may have sudden flashes of insight. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life when Uranus makes contact with your personal planets.

**Neptune starts the month at 13 Aquarius 51.'** If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed when Neptune transits your personal planets. Neptune ends the month at 14 Aquarius 56'.

**Pluto starts the month at 22 Sagittarius 44'** and ends up at 23 Sagittarius 43' on the 31st. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing.

**SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

### **NEW MOON January 10, 2005 - 20 Capricorn 21'**

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Capricorn rules the 10th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be your career/profession, public reputation and/or recognition, business affairs, real estate, the government or your mother.

### **SABIAN SYMBOL for 21 CAPRICORN:**

#### **A RELAY RACE**

A relay race is a competition where people work together to run as fast as you can to pass the finish line. Each person in the race must trust the other to pass the baton in a timely manner for the sake of the team. Working together reaps reward. Positive Keywords: Teamwork, encouragement, completion, sharing and trust. Negative Keywords: Competitiveness, acting in ones own best interest, not letting go of controlling others.

### **FULL MOON January 25, 2005 - 05 Leo 34'**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the January 25th Full Moon falls in the sign of Leo, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Leo is a fixed, fire sign and resides in the 5th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by our Sun. Issues involving your children, creativity, romance or romantic attractions may be your focus or highlighted. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

### **SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 06 LEO:**

## **AN OLD FASHIONED "CONSERVATIVE" WOMAN IS CONFRONTED BY AN UP-TO-DATE GIRL**

Generational differences, confronting differences, our opposite and our past is symbolic. The aging process, role reversals, fear of differences and jealousy is possible. Perhaps the conservative woman feels threatened by the up-to date girl or visa versa.

Projection of our shadow is possible since we were all once young and at difference stages of development usually want what we don't have.

### **SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:**

### **SYMBOLS/OMENS/SYNCHRONICITY**

Most Astrologers ascribe to the rule of 3 when interpreting an astrological birth chart. What this means is that when analyzing a chart, understanding the personality or whether or not a character trait will manifest, we look for 3 occurrences to validate the quality or trait. With 3 aspects (planetary connections) we feel comfortable in asserting that this quality will operate within the native's life.

In my own life, I pay close attention to events or symbols that present themselves to me, especially when they appear in 3's. For instance, recently while gardening in front of my house, I found a ladybug on a leaf. I thought this odd since it is winter here in New Jersey! Then one day within a week of finding that ladybug, while exercising at my gym, there was a ladybug right in front of me on my exercise mat! How did a ladybug find its way into the gym and end up in the middle of my gym mat? Within the very same week, while at my office I located another ladybug in the middle of a desk. I've always loved ladybugs and call them "wishing" bugs as they lucky. The number of spots on the ladybug tells you how many wishes you have! I felt pretty lucky. Also, it has been said that the appearance of a lady bug hints at a new relationship. The direction the ladybug leaves you, North, South, East or West, foretells of the direction that new partner will come from!

When I was pregnant with my daughter, I attended these Lamaze classes. In these classes you are taught the importance of correct breathing during contractions. This breathing is supposed to alleviate the discomfort of labor and assist in pushing the baby out with ease. When I was in hard labor (all 23 hours of it), and pushing (3 \_ hours) all I could think about was my wanting to go to go home and to get out of that hospital. I was physically exhausted, while well meaning doctors and the midwife barked orders to "breathe". "I am breathing", I replied, you just can't hear me!! I later realized that all that breathing stuff was really a distraction technique...to distract from the main issue and that was the physical pain of birthing a child with no painkillers!

One time, while asleep, I felt a hand on my breast bone and a feeling that I was being watched. The discomfort I felt, in my sleep, forced me awake to find an ex partners face, just inches away from mine staring at me, as I slept. Startled, I jumped up asking "What

are you doing, what's wrong?" And the reply was, "I didn't think you were breathing, and I was concerned that you were dead, you weren't moving"!! I don't move much while I'm asleep and I'm a shallow breather, and I can see how this breathing issue was getting in the way of my life! ☺

A couple of months ago, I received a poem from a friend entitled "Breathe" and it left quite an impression on me. Not only did the poem leave an impression on me but the title of the poem was startling given what I have written above, and what that word symbolically means to me. There is a song I had been listening to before receipt of that poem with the same title whose lyrics I will post here for you below that is reminiscent of the reason for the receipt of that poem with the same name entitled "Breathe".

On Christmas Eve, a friend and I played a game called the Transformational All Game (I think that is the name of it). In this game, there are different areas of life that we require focus on; the emotional, intellectual, spiritual etc. in relationship to the question or purpose we chose at the beginning of the game. We roll the dice and move our pieces in the board game and wherever we land provides the opportunity to choose an Awareness, Service, or Angel card etc. On my first turn, one of the 6 Awareness cards I chose had the word "breath" on the card. I had to chuckle to myself...what message is the Universe revealing to me...again? What's with this breathe message?

The point is that it's important to pay attention to synchronous events in our lives. More importantly, when events appear in 3 occurrences, pay closer attention. It is necessary to "connect the dots", to see what message is being revealed to you. In our very preoccupied and busy lives we do not always pay attention to the clues and messages around us. Sometimes we feel that life is taking our breath away and we need to take time to "catch our breath". There is also the expression about "I won't hold my breath waiting for ..such and such to happen". Ushering in this New Year, given the recent catastrophic world events, perhaps we need to take a deep breath, count to ten before we react and then let it out. When we exhale, we rid the body and mind of all that is toxic. Symbolically we need to take in new experiences, process them and recycle them too in order to grow. Everything happens for a reason and those reasons are often revealed to you in the form of synchronous events. It is those very synchronous events that bring a heightened awareness or new path of focus into your life..so pay attention!
