**Happy Birthday Aquarius the Water Bearer!** For those born from January 20 - February 19! Key Phrase for Aquarius is "I KNOW"

Aquarius is a Fixed (settled, stubborn), air (thought and intellect) sign located in the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Aquarius governs the 11<sup>th</sup> house of the natural zodiac. The 11<sup>th</sup> house involves areas of our life such as friendships, organizations, associations, clubs, our hopes and wishes, finances of the employer, our mother's money (it's the 2<sup>nd</sup> house from the 10<sup>th</sup>), step children (7<sup>th</sup> from the 5<sup>th</sup>) as well as counselors, acquaintances and Astrologers. Aquarians are considered the entrepreneurs and philanthropists of the zodiac.

You are rebellious, eccentric and humanitarian. Aquarius in health issues relates to the ankles, calves and nervous system. Illnesses may develop in the central nervous system when Uranus transits make difficult angle/aspect connections in your birth chart. (conjunction, square, opposition, quincunx and quincunx)

Your ruling planet is the erratic and unpredictable planet Uranus. In traditional astrology, Uranus is considered to be a derelict because he brings sudden, unexpected change into your life. Think of the Tower in the Tarot Deck. When Uranus transits our chart he usually brings some kind of catastrophic change to your life. If you have Uranus strong in your birth chart, you may be drawn to the unusual, creative, non-conforming or the anti-establishment. Aquarians are known for their inventiveness, being a little "off the top" and have no interest in convention. Uranus rules electricity, the Internet and yes, Astrologers! Some people think Astrologers are a little "weird"!! It's not that we are, you know, it's just that we have a unique way of looking at the world and others. I should say, we are not afraid to see or speak the truth! Because Aquarians are so "quirky" they may have a sense or feeling of being outcasts or even of being adopted by their family of origin. They don't always feel they fit in.

Uranus is "electric" and rules the nervous system and the ankles/lower calf. Even the astrological glyph for the sign of Aquarius resembles electric waves. Other health issues to watch during a Uranus transit affecting your birth chart might manifest in nervous energy, sciatic pain, ankle or calf cramps, edginess and nervous irritability and tension.

When Uranus transits in your birth chart and makes a 180 degree angle with our natal Uranus at approximately age 41-43, we have what is called our Uranus Opposition, or one of our Mid-life crises. Kundalini energy forces expression during this time. During this time we have the need to break free from the status quo. Marriages and relationships come up for review and/or undergo tremendous changes or end completely. Sometimes a marriage will take place while other relationships end or the dynamics change. We may encounter different types of people and associate with others of a different background, culture other than what we are usually comfortable or accustomed with. We seek new experiences and have no desire to be tied down. Any attempt to limit one's individuality will be fought with intense rebellion.

Aquarian, Uranian energy thinks "out of the box". They are our iconoclasts, futurists and inventors.

## **PALLAS ATHENE - ASSOCIATED WITH AQUARIUS**

Pallas Athene, Minerva (Roman), the Greek Goddess of Wisdom, sprang from Zeus's (Jupiter) head fully formed and cloaked in armor. She symbolizes a woman with the intellect of a man. Because she was borne of man and not woman she is symbolic of a "Uranian" type of matriarchal energy.

She was well liked, resourceful and earned the trust of others, especially men. Although a Warrior Woman, she is peaceful in her strength and wisdom. She also represents justice and righteousness and her tendency to fight for the underdog. Her inner courage enables and protects her in surviving battles. She enjoys competition and has skill in most sport. Her association with the Owl, symbolic of inner wisdom and special visual perception, is well deserved. She is "Joan of Arc", the stereotypical creative, intelligent woman with abundance of inner strength.

In your chart, she is symbolic of the way a woman makes her way in a man's world. She symbolizes a woman's relationship with her father. In her wisdom, she also had the role of counselor to her father. You can then substitute this symbolism for the way she treats males in general and in relationship with them. Men with a strong Pallas need to stand up for their rights.

In addition to her war-like nature, "she was credited with inventing weaving, the potter's wheel, spinning, needlework, and was also associated with navigation and agriculture, especially the olive tree". - Lee Lehman, Ph.D., *The Ultimate Asteroid Book*. Olive flower essence restores energy when you are physically and "mentally" exhausted.

Her ability to plan, strategize and carry out those plans utilizing systems and concepts is her strength. She is indicator of our intelligence and our style of perception. Although perceived to be somber and serious, she is strong and takes decisive action and never whines.

Pallas is also symbolic of the mind/body connection and the healing arts in general. Flashes of insight and genius along with creative works of art are indicative of a prominently placed Pallas.

She is also associated with androgyny. She has the unique ability to express both her feminine and masculine side. Negatively, Pallas would identify more with men than with women and could lose part of her femininity. Since she wore a protective suit of armor to ease her into a man's world, this could symbolize the defense mechanism of intellectualizing and rationalizing situations to place distance between the self and others so as to not experience feeling and pain.

Interestingly, while Pallas was respected and admired by men she was never quite validated by them as a woman. Her creative abilities and intellect were not considered to be "feminine" traits desirable in attracting men, even though she was attractive in appearance. Most daughters/women are taught to play dumb and conditioned by society that women should repress their creative expression to avoid rejection from men. My own mother lectured to never allow a man to know how smart one is, while my father would talk about how men prefer women who are a little helpless, since men have some primitive urge to save women.

A modern day Pallas Athene is a woman of the New Age, unwilling to compromise any part of whom she is to be in a relationship. Equality is her goal in relationships which is why Pallas is also linked to the partnership sign of Libra.

With Pallas' association with Uranus and Aquarius, her prominence in your chart will indicate how you, if you're a woman, operate in a "man's" world, and if you're a man, how you operate in a "woman's" world. It is also symbolic of how you place aside your sexual nature in order to relate platonically to the opposite sex either in a business or friendship.

#### **THE TOWER Card - Number XVI - 16 - Uranus**

The Tower card in the Tarot deck is card #16 and symbolizes sudden destruction in our lives. The lightning bolts striking the crown of the tower represents sudden change and events in our lives that we were not prepared for. Change always inspires growth and transformation after the reality and acceptance of those changes is accepted. Reorientation to these changes and challenges is important and the need to realize that the status quo is an "illusion" we create. Nothing remains the same.

The Tower is typically symbolic of the planet Mars, but I always equate this card with Uranus' electrical, lightning response and the impact of sudden awareness in our psyche. It's the "a-ha" card in the Tarot deck.

When Uranus transits your birth chart or if Uranus is significantly placed in your chart, you may experience nervous energy and events may suddenly and unexpectedly unfold in your life.

When The Tower appears in a reading, the truth is exposed, sometimes with life shattering consequences. Oftentimes it will appear in a relationship reading to shed light or reveal the "reality" of the situation. We then gain insight or a heightened awareness after a painful experience. A relationship may end or drastically change course. We are often caught off guard when the Tower appears.

#### **Tarot Card # 17 XVII - The Star - Symbolic of Aquarius**

In the Rider Waite version, you see the body of a naked woman holding an urn in each hand. One urn pours water onto the land (material world) while the other urn is poured into a pool of water (spirituality). One of her feet is planted firmly on the ground while the other

grazing the surface of the pool. Her nakedness symbolizes acceptance of her self while the pouring of water symbolizes the quest for balancing both our spiritual and material needs.

Card 17 reduced, equals the number 8. Eight is the number of power and authority signifying success and material fortune. Above her head are 8 stars, 7 smaller stars and one large bright star in the center. Stars symbolize the guiding light within all of us that knows that we are protected "under the stars". We need to see the light within ourselves to be "enlightened". This means that you need to let go of your inhibitions (nakedness) and open yourself up to your own truth.

Negatively, and all cards have a positive and negative influence, in your reading this is interpreted as a shutting off of your spirituality or love for another. Perhaps too much self-love becomes narcissistic or this is person always searching or looking towards the distant star or a long-lost or idealistic love. Then the need to stop dreaming and "manifest" your reality is the message. We do this by permitting the "natural" flow of emotions to thaw rather than having them freeze up. Sometimes we freeze our emotions as a defense mechanism so that no one will hurt us.

The Symbol of "The Star" may appear in a reading during a time when spiritual or emotional healing is necessary and to see that we are pure and good under the light of the shining stars above. As above, so below...the stars above mirror the light within each of us.

### **REST AND CLEANSING MOON (Otter)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from January 20<sup>th</sup> - February 18<sup>th</sup> are born under the Rest and Cleansing Moon and their animal totem is the Otter. Their color is silver and silver is also their totem in the mineral kingdom. There are of the Butterfly Elemental clan.

The color silver is thought to have magical properties and that "it is the silver chord that holds the soul to the body". - Medicine Wheel Astrology. Otter people are usually very intuitive and have the capacity to become telepathic more easily than most. They are the visionaries and love heated discussions and intellectual debate. Otters are considered to be the organizers of the animal kingdom and they maintain elaborate dens, like a house, broken into rooms.

According to the Medicine Cards by Jamie Sams & David Carson, Otter is Woman Medicine and lessons in female energy. Otter is very caring of its young and will play with them for hours. They live on land but always have a place near the water. Otters are very curious animals and are in constant motion. They are adventurous and friendly. Otter people express joy for others and are never jealous or "catty". They are feminine creatures, sleek and gentle.

### **February, 2005**

**Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 \_ days.**

**February 2, 2005: Jupiter turns Retrograde (rx)** - Jupiter starts the month at 18 Libra 51' and ends the month at 17 Libra 46'. In the Venus ruled sign of Libra, Jupiter is expansive, loving and warm in love matters. Relationships are highlighted while Jupiter transits Libra. While retrograde the actions of Jupiter are internalized. According to Astrologer, Lynn Koiner, "Jupiter rules role playing in order evoke a positive external reaction. When transiting Jupiter is afflicting natal planets, you will find yourself dealing with phoniness in both yourself and others. When Jupiter is retrograde, you should evaluate how you are not being honest with yourself because you are playing a role that is disloyal to your true self. When opportunities arise while Jupiter is retrograde, they are the result of seeds planted in the past from people met or connections made in the past." Jupiter will retrograde until June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2005, and turns direct at 08 Libra 55'.

**February 3, 2005: Venus enters Aquarius** - Venus in Aquarius is unique and unpredictable in love and chooses a partner or relationship with some inherent "distance". The need for individualism is prominent in this placement.

**February 7, 2005: Mars enters hard working Capricorn** - Mars in Capricorn is practical with the ability to overcome obstacles in life. Mastery of will is the lesson for Mars in this sign. Concentration on the goal is heightened.

**February 10, 2005: New Moon 20 Aquarius 21'**. A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. Aquarius, ruled by Uranus, is the 11th sign of the zodiac. This is a positive time to work on the associations you have with others, groups you belong to, your hopes and dreams and technology issues. Attention to ankles and nervous system is beneficial during this time.

**February 14, 2005: Happy Valentine's Day!** On this day both Venus planet of love and beauty is in the exact same degree as illusive Neptune, both in the sign of Aquarius. Venus in Aquarius already holds unconventional ideas about love, and coupled with wispy Neptune emphasizes fantasy and perfectionism. Until we face imperfections in ourselves we may project them onto our partner and become disillusioned not seeing them clearly. Positively this blending of energy receives assistance from benevolent Jupiter inspiring generosity in love and affection. Romance is underscored and the expression of it sort of quirky and off-beat. The Moon in the earthy sign of Taurus is at odds with Venus and Neptune and your feelings for the one you love may be blurred. You may be unable to clearly articulate your feelings. It's important to go into your heart and stay out of your intellect with these astrological influences. See more about this day under the "Soul Mate/Relationships" section below.

**February 17, 2005: Mercury enters intuitive Pisces.** Mercury in mutable Pisces is thoughtful and compassionate. Psychic revelations and accurate intuition is highlighted.

**February 19, 2005: Sun enters Pisces** - Happy Birthday Pisces! Pisces is a mutable (flexible) and water (emotional) sign. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Pisces in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

**February 24, 2005: Full Moon 05 Virgo 41'** - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Virgo the focus is on your work, health, pets, assimilating information, aunts and uncles the solar plexus and intestines.

**Saturn in Cancer continues his retrograde (rx) through March 22, 2005** - Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 22 Cancer 24'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. When retrograde we have the opportunity to finish or renegotiate projects we have started. He ends the month at 20 Cancer 49'. Whatever needs to be redone, reevaluated and reworked will be the focus during Saturn's retreat.

**Uranus in Pisces** - Uranus starts the month at 05 Pisces 24' and will end the month at 06 Pisces 56'. For instance, when Uranus transits opposite natal Venus, you may encounter a new love or the break up of an existing relationship. If you have a daughter, she may prove more rebellious or in need of freedom. If Uranus is transiting opposite natal Mercury, you may feel more restless and not need as much sleep. You may have sudden flashes of insight. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life when Uranus makes contact with your personal planets.

**Neptune starts the month at 14 Aquarius 59.'** If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed when Neptune transits your personal planets. Neptune ends the month at 15 Aquarius 59'.

**Pluto starts the month at 23 Sagittarius 44'** and ends up at 24 Sagittarius 19' on the 31st. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing.

**SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

### **NEW MOON February 8, 2005 - 20 Aquarius 16'**

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Aquarius rules the 11th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be your friends, hopes, wishes, groups and organizations, the mother's money, step children and the finances of your employer.

### **SABIAN SYMBOL for 21 AQUARIUS:**

#### **A WOMAN DISAPPOINTED AND DISILLUSIONED, COURAGEOUSLY FACING A SEEMINGLY EMPTY LIFE**

This image is one of disappointment and loss causing some sadness. This woman feels unfulfilled in some area of her life, as if something is missing or lacking as well as the apparent perception of loss. However, this may only be a perception because even when there is a loss of a relationship or a restriction or limitation placed upon us, it is usually a time of tremendous growth, though we don't usually feel this way at the time.

The feeling or belief that we may not ever achieve or get what we desire can become a self fulfilling prophecy. All is never lost and there is always darkness before the sun emerges on the horizon.

### **FULL MOON February 24, 2005 - 05 Virgo 34'**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the February 24th Full Moon falls in the sign of Virgo, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Virgo is a mutable, earth sign and resides in the 6th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by Mercury the messenger. Issues involving work, people who work for you, health issues and pets will be highlighted. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely

to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

#### **SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 06 VIRGO:**

##### **A MERRY-GO-ROUND**

Merry-go-rounds are adored by children as well as adults. The thrill of moving around in a circle causes dizziness while listening to the carnival-like music, placing us in a trance-like state.

Going around in circles and falling down can be fun when you are a child, but going around in circles as an adult is tiring, stressful and self sabotaging. This symbol tells us to think clearly and be more definite; to stop going around in circles with our thoughts or behavior. When we do we get no where. Here we may feel as if we are stuck in obsessive thoughts or repetitious circumstances. At some point you need to make a decision and stand firmly in that choice.

Negatively this might indicate vacillating emotions or emotional responses. Addictive behavior is indicated. Feeling unfocused or wishy-washy is also possible.

##### **EROS - ASTEROID #433**

Discussion of the month of February would not be complete without having discussed a couple of asteroids that relate to our "lovers" holiday - Valentine's Day!

"Eros has sex for the intimacy and power it brings and for the potential to transform by touching the divine soul of another, **at whatever cost.**" - Kim Falconer's article in Dell Horoscope, 2004. It is Eros who soars all over the earth, equipped with his bow and arrow, "bewitching" all the arrow strikes. The symbolism is such that erotic love and passion strikes us when we least expect us. The way we respond to these sudden feelings are dependent on our temperament and how evolved we are. Do our lives become chaotic and unpredictable? Do we become obsessed and possessed by these passions? When Eros transits our birth chart, it may indicate areas of our lives where erotic love and passion may awaken and have the power to transform us.

Martha Lang-Wescott, in her book Mechanics of the Future - Asteroids, says this of Eros: "Eros represents what turns us on and defines sexual interest. It is the essential element of the survival instinct, and for this reason, it is often prominent in death charts when the "drive to love" is shadowed by transit and/or directions or progressions.

Do you know where Asteroid Eros is located in your birth chart? In synastry; chart compatibility, if your Eros is conjunct or opposite your partners, Moon, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Neptune, Uranus, Pluto or their Name asteroid (yes, most of you have an asteroid named after yourself!) this will prove another indication of erotic/sexual attraction/love.

On February 14<sup>th</sup>, asteroid **Eros** will be transiting 2 degrees of Scorpio. Eros will be trining (easy flowing) the Sun, Mercury, Uranus and Juno with a sextile to Mars and a Septile to Pluto...how exciting! ☺

### VALENTINE - ASTEROID # 447

As synchronicity would have it, Valentine is asteroid number 447. In numerology, this number adds up to the number 6! (4+4+7=15 or 1+5 = 6) The number 6 just happens to be the Lovers Card in the Tarot deck and symbolic of compassionate love, service and often the "Soul Mate". Astrologically, asteroid Valentine has a strong relationship to the 7<sup>th</sup> house of one-to-one relationships. These aren't only "love" relationships and can indicate business partnerships, open enemies in a law suit. ie: the other lawyer.

When we were children, we would often send those cute little "Valentine's" in the shape of a heart to the one we desire and love. Asteroid Valentine can indicate something we send to another or receive from another ie: letters, legal documents or even junk e-mail!

Where is asteroid Valentine located in your birth chart?

Transiting **Valentine** will be at **9 Libra** retrograde (rx) on Valentine's Day, February 14, 2005.
