Happy Birthday Pisces! For those born between February 19th - March 20th The Key Phrase is: I Believe. Pisces is a Mutable (changeable, flexible), water (feelings and emotions) sign located in the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Pisces governs the last house, the 12th house, of the natural zodiac. The 12th house includes areas of our life such as hospitals, institutions, confinement, dreams, large animals, psychic influences and meditation, solitude, secret sorrows, sensing, and the subconscious to name a few. Pisceans are usually the people who are willing to most sacrifice themselves for others. They are compassionate and idealistic, often to a fault. If you have a Pisces Sun, or if you have planets located in the 12th house in your birth chart, you are often very intuitive and have psychic ability. Several of my friends are Pisces or have Neptune, the ruling planet, prominent in their birth chart.

The Piscean personality is mutable (changeable) and easily influenced by family and friends rather than paying closer attention to their keen intuition. They see and know things about others that often are not validated. Because of this Pisces begins to believe that their reality of others is wrong. The truth is that others are not as keenly aware or in denial about what Pisces and planets in the 12^{th} see so easily.

Pisces in health issues relates to the feet and immune system ... strange illnesses that creep up on you or that were hidden such as anemia, HIV, AIDS, or Herpes may develop. Pisces' polar opposite (12th house - hospitals) is Virgo (6th house - health). The immune system is

under strain when Neptune makes difficult angle connections by transit in your birth chart. (conjunctions, squares, oppositions and quincunx)

Your ruling planet is the romantic, dreamy, wispy, illusive and mutable planet Neptune. Neptune is fog...you simply can't "grasp" it and it's often too dense to see through it. If Neptune is strong in your chart, you may have artistic or musical ability. The image I have of Neptune is the Good Fairy sprinkling fairy dust that temporarily clouds your good judgment. Since Neptune/Pisces rules the feet, ballet dancers and dancers of all kinds may fall under Neptune's domain. Negatively, if Pisces isn't in tune with their inner calling they can fall prey to Neptune and develop addictions of all kinds causing them to lose their way.

Neptune can often "blur" our vision of reality and cause self-deception or draw deceptive people and situations to us. Neptune and/or Neptune transits are prevalent in addictions of all kinds. With Venus/Neptune there could be deception in love, idealistic expectations of the loved one, affairs or alcoholism and drug abuse. The positive manifestation could be artistic and musical ability and a compassionate and romantic nature. Mars/Neptune can dissipate energy, energy "leaks" are common, and passive/aggressive behavior is likely. The positive manifestation might be psychic ability and a romantic nature. Neptune and Pisces often have loose or undefined boundaries. Boundaries are limitations, what we will and will not tolerate from others. They indicate where I begin and end. Often, when Neptune, Pisces and the 12th house are involved, we may have boundary issues especially in our interpersonal relationships. This may have been learned by invasive or overbearing parents or siblings when we were children. We feel deception within the parental household on an unconscious level...parents may have kept secrets from the children or from each other. This may manifest in boundary issues as we grow and begin to engage in relationship. There is something vague, that we do not trust. Sometimes we give up too much or not enough just to be in a relationship or within our friendships or working environment. Often we don't know where to draw the line or you would allow others to overstep your boundaries too often creating a win-lose situation.

Since Pisces is the last sign of the zodiac, some say it is the most spiritually evolved sign because compassion and selflessness are indicative of a person with Pisces energy. Intuition and psychic ability are possible with planets in Pisces, located in the 12th house or in aspect to Neptune. There is a gentleness, softness and innocence related to this sign. One of the 3 emotional water signs, Pisces lives in a world of dreams and romance. This romantic soul wants to feel deeply connected with their partner.

March 13 is also the discovery date of planet Uranus by Herschel in 1781.

THE HANGED MAN Card - Number 12

The Hanged Man card in the Tarot deck is card #12 and is symbolic of sacrifice. In this way the Hanged Man relates to the sign of Pisces. The Hanged Man is hanging upside down, tied by one foot with the other leg folded behind him freely, with his hands behind his back and a lovely glowing halo crowning his head. Upon first glance you may think he is being punished for some reason and being held captive. Upon closer examination, he doesn't look unhappy in this position. He is a willing victim/participant and seems at peace. We often must sacrifice and give up our confining thoughts and ideas from our past in order to see the light and seek enlightenment. We must push aside temptations or instant gratification and just "hang around" and wait it out! When I see this card in a reading it can mean the need to take a pause in the question at hand. Sometimes it means a lack of commitment in a relationship reading or being at a stand still or cross roads. Someone isn't sure about the relationship...only one foot in the relationship.

BIG WINDS MOON (Cougar)

In Native American Astrology, those born from February 19th - March 20th are born under the Big Winds Moon and their animal totem is the Cougar. Their color is blue-green of the

turquoise and turquoise is also their totem in the mineral kingdom. They are of the Frog Elemental clan.

The stone turquoise is one of the oldest stones used for adornment and protection. Native Americans utilize this stone is much of their jewelry. When worn it was thought to keep its owner from injury or danger.

Cougar people often have healing powers with the ability to heal others. They are comfortable in magical and mystical realms. These people have the ability to absorb both positive and negative energy from others so it is important for them to always stay grounded in earth.

The Cougar is the largest cat in North America. Like all cats, cougar is a hunter and enjoys the chase in a hunt. Cougar/Puma is a mountain lion and is solitary and territorial. This cat is one of the best runners and climbers. Their speed and endurance is exemplary. They are also swift in their mind and capable to going to distant places that few others travel. Their ability to sit perched and still for hours to ambush his prey is unmatched. This is one of the few cats who will hunt during the day.

The also have stalking ability; the ability to move in silence. Balance is essential to their well being. When off balance they become moody but with the proper direction can be most productive. When cougar appears as your animal totem, he often warns of a lesson that comes in terms of an experience. Coming into your own power, exerting your influence, patience and silence and increased intuitive ability would be utilized if under personal attack.

March, 2005

Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 _ days.

March 1, 2005: Venus in Pisces enters Aries on March 23 – Venus in Pisces seeks love of music and comfort in love. Romance is high in this sign as Venus is exalted and quite comfortable in Pisces. Venus moving into Aries is dynamic and falls in love quickly and falls out of love just as quickly wanting some new adventure.

March 5, 2005: Mercury enters fiery Aries. Mercury in cardinal Aries is a quick thinker and fast communicator. Words fly!

March 10, 2005: New Moon 19 Pisces 54'. A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. Pisces, ruled by Neptune, is the 12th sign of the zodiac. This is a positive time to devote to your dream life, working with your unconscious and self defeating behaviors. Secrets may be revealed or uncovered. Attention to immune system and blood deficiency issues is beneficial during this time.

March 17, 2005 - Happy St. Patrick's Day!

March 20, 2005: Mercury in Aries turns retrograde at 14 Pisces 05'. When Mercury is moving backwards it is a time to redo, revise and renegotiate the areas of life indicated by its placement in your chart. It is not a good time to sign contracts or enter into any agreements because there is something you are unaware of or not reading correctly. Perhaps the other party left out some critical information. Backing up your computer is essential because miscommunications of all kinds are likely.

March 20, 2005: Vernal Equinox or Spring Equinox - Sun enters Aries - Happy Birthday Aries! New Beginnings are in store for you when the Sun enters O Aries. Aries is a cardinal (initiator, go-getter) and fire (intuition) sign. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Aries in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

March 20th is also Palm Sunday and International Astrology Day!

March 21, 2005: Mars in Capricorn goes into Aquarius – Mars in Capricorn is practical with the ability to overcome obstacles in life. Mastery of will is the lesson for Mars in this sign. Concentration on the goal is heightened. When Mars enters Uranus ruled Aquarius, actions become less predictable and more erratic and inventive.

March 25, 2005: Full Moon 05 Libra 18' - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Libra, relationships of all kinds are highlighted. If you have been pondering a decision regarding your most intimate relationship, this Full moon will emphasize either moving forward or bringing closure. Watch your sugar intake during this Full Moon!

Jupiter Retrograde (rx) – Jupiter starts the month at 17 Libra 42' and ends the month at 14 Libra 22'. In the Venus ruled sign of Libra, Jupiter is expansive, loving and warm in love matters. Relationships are highlighted while Jupiter transits Libra. While retrograde the actions of Jupiter are internalized. According to Astrologer, Lynn Koiner, "Jupiter rules role playing in order evoke a positive external reaction. When transiting Jupiter is afflicting natal planets, you will find yourself dealing with phoniness in both yourself and others. When Jupiter is retrograde, you should evaluate how you are not being honest with yourself because you are playing a role that is disloyal to your true self. When opportunities arise while Jupiter is retrograde, they are the result of seeds planted in the past from people met or connections made in the past." Jupiter will retrograde until June 5th, 2005, and turns direct at 08 Libra 55'.

Saturn in Cancer continues his retrograde (rx) through March 22, 2005 - Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 20 Cancer 47'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove

yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. When retrograde we have the opportunity to finish or renegotiate projects we have started. He turns direct on March 22nd at 20 Cancer 28'. Saturn will reach the degree it started its backward motion on June 26th at 27 Cancer 28'.

Uranus in Pisces - Uranus starts the month at 06 Pisces 59' and will end the month at 08 Pisces 38. For instance, when Uranus transits opposite natal Venus, you may encounter a new love or the break up of an existing relationship. If you have a daughter, she may prove more rebellious or in need of freedom. If Uranus is transiting opposite natal Mercury, you may feel more restless and not require as much sleep. You may have sudden flashes of insight. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life when Uranus makes contact with your personal planets.

Neptune starts the month at 16 Aquarius 01.' If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed when Neptune transits your personal planets. Neptune ends the month at 16 Aquarius 57'.

Pluto starts the month at 24 Sagittarius 19 and will begin its backward motion on March 27th at 24 Sagittarius 30'. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing. When Pluto's energy turns inward we begin to own our own power and looking within for a better understanding of our subconscious urges.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

NEW MOON March 10, 2005 - 19 Pisces 54'

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Pisces rules the 12th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus could be on your unconscious, dream life, uncovering secrets, romantic ideals, psychic and intuitive ability, and donating time to your favorite charity.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 20 PISCES:

A TABLE SET FOR AN EVENING MEAL

This image is one of advance preparation. A table setting is placed with the expectation that a meal will be served. Perhaps guests will visit and it will be a happy occasion or cause for celebration. Meals bring people together so they can sit face to face. Communication is often lighthearted discussing the day when eating around an evening meal or dinner. Eating food is a source of nourishment, enjoyment and peace.

Preparing for someone's arrival as well as having the fruits of your labors rewarded is demonstrated in this symbol.

FULL MOON March 25, 2005 - 05 Libra 18'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the March 25th Full Moon falls in the sign of Libra, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Libra is a cardinal, air sign and resides in the 7th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by Lady Venus. Partnerships, marriage enemies, defendants in a lawsuit, and people you meet will be highlighted. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

I so like this image because it is one I live by and it is conjunct my natal Moon! When you know what you want and have the ability to visualize in your mind's eye what you desire, you can actually have it materialize in your life over time. Yet we need to have an inner vision and want it so much that the intense desire manifests into form. You tend to work harder when you want something badly enough. If your thoughts and desires are pure, then the Universe answers your "prayers".

When you focus your thoughts and visualize or meditate on what you want, you can bring those creative ideas into reality. You can make things happen in your life by communicating your wishes to the Universe.

Romantic relationships end for a variety of reasons.
