Happy Birthday Cancer! The Moon-Child! For those born between June 21 - July 22nd

The Key Phrase is: I Nurture. The astrological glyph is the Crab in the shape of a sideways 69. Cancer is a cardinal (action oriented, initiator), water (emotion, sensitive, feeling) sign located in the 2nd quadrant (other oriented/inter-personal) of the Western Hemisphere of the chart. Because Cancer resides in the 4th house of the zodiac and is ruled by our satellite The Moon: emotions, feelings, children, ancestry, cooking and the home are most important to Cancer. Emotional comfort and personal security in the home is critical to a Cancer. The Moon is often called a "light" or "luminary". In astrological circles, she is symbolic of our instinctual emotional nature, how we may or may not have been nurtured as a child and our "perception" of our own mother. I call her "she" as the Moon is feminine (yin) in nature and linked to the astrological sign of Cancer. She is receptive as she retreats during the day, hidden from view, and absorbs the light of her partner, The Sun, to reflect that light back to us in the evening, once the Sun has disappeared from view.

In relationships, Cancer is caring, responsible, romantic, sensitive and sensual. There isn't anything Cancer will not do for their partner and loved ones. They are generous with their time, love and possessions once trust is developed. As with all the water signs (Pisces and Scorpio), trust is critical. Security and loyalty are most important to Cancer folks which

are why betrayal in love has such a devastating effect. Scorpio's might say "Don't get mad, get even", but a Cancer never forgets...and some say they never forgive the emotional betrayal although rationally they do. Considered to be old-fashioned, Cancer's are sentimental and save and collect just about everything. They are the ones who stay in contact with old friends and save memorabilia. Their memories and intuition are acute and store past emotional memories and impressions with accuracy and detail. They are devoted to their mate and family.

Cancer the crab has a hard outer shell and a very soft interior. Crabs crawl into their shells when they are frightened and will move at a slow and constant pace. If you watch a crab move he tends to move from side to side, not front to back. This symbolism is often prominent in those who lunar ruled as the often will not confront a problem or person straight on. When the Sun is in the sign of Cancer it combines the union of opposites both Solar and Lunar energy, the masculine and feminine. In the book Mythic Astrology by Guttman and Johnson, when a person is born under the sign of Cancer it said to be "the sign of the "mystic marriage", the union of alchemical opposites". For this reason, Cancer people are said to be psychic for they are very open to universal energies.

Lunar-ruled Cancer in health issues relates to the breasts and stomach. These body parts relate to the nurturing instinct ie: breasts for feeding babies and the stomach for feeling full - of food. When we think of the disease Cancer and the proliferation of Breast Cancer in women, we see women who give too much and don't speak up for themselves and their own needs. As a result, the pattern becomes so internalizes that a disease develops to render the 'giver" incapable of giving because they are too ill to give. The reverse happens where the "nurturer" becomes the one requiring nurturing.

Cancer's polar opposite (4th house - home, our roots, end of the matter, children, family food and nurturing) is the cardinal, earth sign Capricorn (10th house- career, public reputation). The integration of home and family versus work and the public is one area of life for Cancer, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite....the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Cancer can become cold as ice, willful and decisive...just like earthy Capricorn (the Sea Goat) ruled by planet Saturn. Remember too that Saturn is the ancient ruler of Aquarius and you can add that "flavor" to the above interpretation. Aquarians often seem distant or cool as they are an air sign and tend to "think" their emotions.

THE CHARIOT - Number VII - Cancer

In The Tarot deck, card #7 - The Chariot is symbolic of the sign of Cancer. The Chariot is the director of his own destiny so long as he stays focused along his path. He leads the way with his unwavering focus, ambition and determination. He does seem anxious to get to where he wants to go, which isn't always where he needs to be. Sometimes his focus and determination will be to his detriment. It's always important to look up from time to time to see what is going on around you. Over ambitious and excessive desire to pursue and reach a goal "at any cost" can sometimes be the "not seeing the forest from the trees" and actually sabotage one's goals rather than achieve them!

The black and white Sphinx's are symbolic of opposing forces that need to be blended together. Each color wants to move in a different direction and it is the Charioteer's job to prevent this with his powers of concentration, focus and determination. Sometimes decisions are made with black and white thinking rather than seeing the shades of gray. Balance and compromise to the middle ground is required when this card appears.

When I see this card I have a sense of the blending of yin and yang, feminine and masculine energies we possess. The Chariot in a reading gently reminds us of this need to blend our assertive and receptive energies. Androgyny is implied. He also symbolizes the destiny we make for ourselves as well as our inward journey. He is also considered a workaholic, actively exerting control over his environment.

STRONG SUN MOON (Flicker)

In Native American Astrology, those born from **June 21** - **July 22nd** are born under the Strong Sun Moon and their animal totem is the **Flicker** or **Woodpecker**. Their color is **pink** and they are part of the **Frog Elemental Clan**. The flicker or woodpecker is known for its perseverance and relentlessness in the face of something it desires or needs for its security or children. The flicker is quick, precise and detail oriented.

Flicker people are home oriented. Having a comfortable and beautiful home is important to Flickers. They function best when their home; physical, emotional or mental is attractive and running smoothly.

The carnelian agate is their mineral totem. Carnelian was the first hard stone engraved in ancient times. Because of its color, carnelian has been associated with blood. It was considered to be a stone used in emergencies and useful in healing people. It was thought to be able to stop blood flowing from wounds. Because of its color, it is also associated with the heart. The stone is often given as a pledge of love.

The Woodpecker was known to the Romans as the bird of the god Mars. Because it has powerful neck muscles and with his persistence makes it possible for them to dig in wood for bugs. They are also able to climb up and down trees without a problem. I have seen a woodpecker outside of my window in my yard and he usually hangs upside down on the bark of the tree! "In Greece and Rome, woodpeckers symbolized war, destruction, sudden attacks and storms. Germans called it the Little King in the West and the "King of Birds", Animal Majick by D. J. Conway.

Woodpeckers are also symbolic of prophecy, good luck and a warning for impending trouble.

Our Moon changes signs approximately every $2\frac{1}{2}$ days.

June 21^{st} Summer Solstice - Sun Enters lunar ruled Cancer...the longest day of the year marking the 1^{st} day of Summer.

July 4th - Independence Day! Have a safe and joyous day!

July 6, 2005: New Moon 14 Cancer 31' - A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've passed by. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. In Cancer, your children, family, home, nurturing issues, real estate, and the end of any matter will be highlighted. The breast and stomach are ruled by Cancer.

July 17, 2005 - Saturn in Cancer enters Leo - Saturn starts the month at 28 Cancer 05'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Our outer skin is one of these boundaries that keep us "together". Saturn rules the skin, knees and skeletal structures. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove

- yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. Saturn enters the sign of Leo on July 17th. Saturn in Cancer dealt with maternal issues while Saturn in Leo will restructure what we know about fathering and the ego.
- **July 21, 2005:** Full Moon 28 Capricorn 47'. A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the cardinal sign of Capricorn, this is a positive time to manifest what you desire in your career and public reputation. Real Estate transactions, your public image and reputation as well as parenting issues may take priority.
- July 23, 2005 Mercury in Leo goes Retrograde (rx) until August 16th. Mercury in Leo has a need to be heard and will embellish to get their point across. With Mercury turning backwards communications of all kinds miss the mark. Double check your fax and voice mails, back up your computer, expect delays in transportation and just gie yourself a little extra time.
- July 23, 2005 Venus in Leo enters Virgo. Venus in Leo wants to be adored and will take center stage. With Venus in Leo you seek praise and devotion. Feelings are warm and affectionate. Love of possessions and self indulgent pleasure seeking is possible in this sign. When in Virgo, sensuality is heightened; our feelings are just under the surface and not easily shared. The desire for perfection increases as well as an increased interest in cleanliness, order and details.
- June 23, 2005: Sun enters Leo Happy Birthday Leo! Leo is a fixed fire sign at home in the sign of Leo. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Leo in the next issue of Lunar Notes.
- July 28, 2005 Mars enters fixed, earthy Taurus In Taurus, Mars feel a little stifled at first. He is slow to warm up. Yet once he gets moving he begins to pick up strength and endurance and is in it for the long haul.
- July, 2005 Jupiter in Libra begins the month at 9 Libra 56' and ends the month at 13 Libra 14'. In the Venus ruled sign of Libra, Jupiter is expansive, loving and warm in love matters. Relationships are reviewed and highlighted while Jupiter transits in Libra.
- July, 2005 Uranus in Pisces Retrograde Uranus starts the month at 10 Pisces 39' and will end the month at 09 Pisces 57'. For instance, when Uranus transits opposite natal Venus, you may encounter a new love or the break up of an existing relationship. If you have a daughter, she may prove more rebellious or in need of freedom. If Uranus is transiting opposite natal Mercury, you may feel more restless and not require as much sleep. You may have sudden flashes of insight. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life when Uranus makes contact with your personal planets. With Uranus in backward motion, the need to turn inward is greater.
- Neptune continues to retrograde beginning the month at 17 Aquarius 09'. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's

transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed when Neptune transits your personal planets. Neptune ends up at 16 Aquarius 25' by months end.

Pluto retrograde starts the month at 22 Sagittarius 43'. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing. When Pluto's energy turns inward we begin to own our own power and looking within for a better understanding of our subconscious urges. Inward there is incredible regenerative psychological power. Pluto will end the month at 22 Sagittarius 05'.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

NEW MOON July 6, 2005 - 14 Cancer 31'

New Moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon. In the sign of Cancer, you might consider starting a family, redecorating your home, thinking of the past or your family history, real estate and the end of the matter might be highlighted. The stomach, digestion and breasts are health issues Cancer rules.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 15 CANCER:

A GROUP OF PEOPLE WHO HAVE OVEREATEN AND HAVE ENJOYED IT.

This symbol speaks of overindulgence, feeling full and satisfied. Perhaps there was cause for a celebration and temporary excitement. We all know how we feel after we have over eaten and end to feel too full and lacking in energy, feeling out of sorts.

It is important to enjoy the good life without taking it for granted or thinking others don't measure up because of what you have and can consume. Over spending, over eating, self indulgence and pompous behavior can have serious consequences and can be a humbling experience.

How does this symbol resonate with you? Do you have planets in the sign of Gemini?

FULL MOON JULY 21, 2005 - 28 Capricorn 47'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the July 21st Full Moon falls in the sign of Capricorn, this lunar energy will be emphasized and is called the "parental axis". Capricorn is a cardinal earth and resides in the 10th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by Saturn. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 29 CAPRICORN:

A WOMAN READING TEA LEAVES

This is one of my favorite symbols. It is also conjunct my Part of Fortune opposite my Sun.

This symbol shows a woman gazing into a cup and who is able to read and see things that others don't usually pay attention to. Sometimes we need to take time and stop to notice what others so easily dismiss as unimportant. Sometimes we find "clues" in the strangest of places. We need to take time to pay attention to the indicators around us that portend future events. There is often a message to be found if we take time to see it.

This symbol is one of looking at the world with a different perspective clearing way to heightened intuition and clairvoyance.

SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:

The 4th House - Home Life - Can You Live Together?

Discussion of the sign of Cancer would not be complete without discussing "The Home", the home life and where we retreat after a hard day. The 4th house, also called the IC or 4th house cusp, along with its ruler (the planet that rules the sign on the house cusp) are indicators of what your home environment was like for you as a child growing up. It is also a good indication of the type of atmosphere that soothes our soul. In adulthood, we tend to choose or recreate a similar home environment based upon our early childhood conditioning. In our relationships or in romantic love we initially tend to choose a partner for several reasons, some of which will be for love, sharing values, life goals, interests, desire for family and children and many other reasons. Some couples never consider whether or not they can actually live with their partner on a daily basis. Sometimes we can love a person and not be able to live with them..or visa versa, live well together and not share other equally important qualities. It's a tough act to juggle. However, knowing what type of environment your partner grew up in and what their emotional (Moon) requirements are

would assist you in having a better understanding of, not only your partner's needs, but your own as well. More importantly, whether or not those desires and needs can cohabit peacefully...or not so peacefully, in some cases.

For example, my 4th house cusp or IC is in the sign of Pisces. Pisces is a sensitive, imaginative water sign like Cancer. As an indication of my home life, Pisces, ruled by Neptune (the modern ruler) and Jupiter (the ancient ruler), my home life was quiet and mostly peaceful. I had only one brother and my parents were first separated then divorced so the home was relatively quiet. Had I lived with my father growing up, I'm not so certain my experience of home would have been as peaceful! © Pisces and Neptune is dreamy, romantic, imaginative, creative, psychic and illusive. Neptune energy is hard to grasp, ethereal and often without boundaries. My 4th house ruler located in the private 12th house emphasized this. My family was very open-minded and I learned a variety of cultural beliefs (Jupiter) early in life. At home I was pretty much left on my own to do as I pleased, with few, if any, restrictions or distractions. Because I lived in a guiet, aesthetically pleasing home environment, this fostered my creativity and desire to live in a peaceful environment. In my alone time, I painted, wrote poetry, started to study numerology and astrology and practiced my dancing (ballet) Neptune in the 12th and Pisces ruling the feet. Music was constantly playing in the background. A peaceful and nicely decorated home life that allowed me not only alone time but time to be quiet in order to be creative was part of my early home conditioning. This carries over into my adult relationships in the following ways: My ex husband had the reverse 4th house IC/MC axis as mine...with his 4th house IC being Virgo rather than in Pisces. He was neat and clean and organized and allowed me to do my own thing without too much disruption. Therefore, we were able to live well together for 15 years...even though we had very little in common otherwise. We were great roommates. With Pisces on the 4th, I have taught metaphysics classes in my home and have worked mostly from a home office for the past 14 years. There are angels located in every pastel colored room, and it is quiet. People have mentioned that the "energy" around me and in my home is soothing and peaceful.

Take the reverse, a man I once dated who had Aries on the 4th cusp. He grew up in a chaotic and "busy" alcoholic home. His early home life was unsupportive, passively angry, (ruler of this IC is Mars located in Virgo, verbally critical and extremely disruptive. As an adult he tended to unconsciously (in my opinion) create a similar home environment for himself with total chaos, instability and high tension. As a result, when his life didn't have a new drama he would grow bored and, again, unconsciously create some drama to feel comfort. His home life was drab and colorless, literally. There was no physical color in the home other than browns. How might this home life 'energy" project onto a future live in relationship?

Looking at these examples you can see how easily or not so easily this relationship might play out on a day to day basis. In addition to knowing your potential partners Moon sign, what is soothing on an emotional level and the early nurturing received from mother, knowing the 4^{th} house, planets within and where the ruler of the 4^{th} is located will give you insight on whether or not you can cohabit together or more importantly, how to compromise and find the middle ground.

As mentioned in past issues, also knowing your partners 7^{th} house cusp (the relationship house) and the ruler of that house will provide another indication of the type of partner you may attract.

Knowing the date, time and place of birth is important in making the determination of the Ascendant or Rising sign, the sign rising on the horizon at the time of birth, that set up all the other house cusps that are the divisions of the houses or areas of life.
