Happy Birthday Pisces! For those born between February 19th - March 20th The Key Phrase is: I Believe. Pisces is a Mutable (changeable, flexible), water (feelings and emotions) sign located in the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Pisces governs the last house, the 12th house of the natural zodiac. The 12th house involves areas of our life such as hospitals, institutions, confinement, dreams, large animals, psychic influences and meditation, solitude, secret sorrows, sensing, and the subconscious to name a few. Pisceans are usually the people who are willing to most sacrifice themselves for others. They are compassionate and idealistic, often to a fault. I was asked to do tarot readings for employees on Employee Appreciation Day at an Assisted Care facility. Of the people I read for, 6 were of the sign of Pisces and they were all in a caring profession. These people, or if you have Pisces strong in your birth chart, are often very intuitive and have psychic ability. Most of my friends are Pisces or strongly Neptunian.

Pisces in health issues relates to the feet and immune system ... strange illnesses that creep up on you or that were hidden such as anemia, HIV, AIDS, or Herpes may develop. Pisces' polar opposite (12th house - hospitals) is Virgo (6th house- health) The immune system is under strain when Neptune transits make difficult angle connections in our birth chart. (conjunctions, squares, oppositions and quincunx)

Your ruling planet is the dreamy, wispy, illusive and mutable planet Neptune. Neptune is fog...you simply can't "grasp" it and it's often too dense to see through it. If Neptune is strong in your chart, you may have artistic or musical ability. Since Neptune/Pisces rules the feet, ballet dancers and dancers of all kinds may fall under Neptune's domain. Neptune can "blur" our vision of reality and cause self-deception or draw deceptive people and situations to us. Neptune and/or Neptune transits are prevalent in addictions of all kinds. With Venus/Neptune there could be deception in love, affairs or alcoholism and drug abuse. The positive manifestation could be artistic ability and compassion. Mars/Neptune can dissipate energy, energy "leaks" are common, and passive/aggressive behavior is likely. The positive manifestation might be psychic ability. Neptune and Pisces often have loose boundaries. Boundaries are limitations, what we will and will not tolerate from others.

Often, when Neptune, Pisces and the 12th house are involved, we may have boundary issues especially in our personal relationships. This may stem from invasive or overbearing parents or siblings when we were children. We feel deception within the parental household on an unconscious level...parents may have kept secrets from the children or from each other. This may manifest in boundary issues as we grow and engage in relationship. There is something vague, that we do not trust. Sometimes we give up too much or not enough just to be in a relationship or within our friendship or working environment. Often we don't know where to draw the line or allow others to overstep the boundaries too often using us a doormat.

THE HANGED MAN Card - Number 12

The Hanged Man card in the Tarot deck is card #12 and is symbolic of sacrifice. In this way the Hanged Man relates to the sign of Pisces. The Hanged Man is hanging upside down, tied by one foot with the other leg folded behind him freely, with his hands behind his back and a lovely glowing halo crowning his head. Upon first glance you may think he is being punished for some reason and being held captive. Upon closer examination, he doesn't look unhappy in this position. He is a willing victim/participant and seems at peace. We often must sacrifice and give up our confining thoughts and ideas from our past in order to see the light and seek enlightenment. We must push aside temptations or instant gratification and just "hang around" and wait it out! When I see this card in a reading it can mean the need to take a pause in the question at hand. Sometimes it means a lack of commitment in a relationship reading or being at a stand still or cross roads. Someone isn't sure about the relationship...only one foot in the relationship.

BIG WINDS MOON (Cougar)

In Native American Astrology, those born from February 19th - March 20th are born under the Big Winds Moon and their animal totem is the Cougar. Their color is blue-green of the turquoise and turquoise is also their totem in the mineral kingdom. There are of the Frog Elemental clan.

The stone turquoise is one of the oldest stones used for adornment and protection. Native Americans utilize this stone is much of their jewelry. When worn it was thought to keep its owner from injury or danger.

Cougar people often have healing powers and the ability to heal others. They are comfortable in magical and mystical realms. These people have the ability to absorb both positive and negative energy from others so it is important for them to always stay grounded in earth.

The Cougar is a cat and like all cats, a hunter and enjoys the chase in a hunt. This cat is one of the best runners and climbers. Their speed and endurance is exemplary. They are also swift in their mind and capable to going to distant places that few others travel. Balance is essential to their well being. When off balance they become moody but with the proper direction can be most productive.

MARCH 2003

February 22, 2003 – Saturn Direct 22 Gemini 08' Decisions will now be made and we will feel a greater ability to act. Saturn isn't most comfortable in the sign of Gemini. Gemini is mutable air and changes. Nothing stays the same in Gemini and that causes anxiety for Saturn who prefers things to be settled.

March 1, 2003 - Mars is OOB or Out of Bounds until March 19th. When a planet is Out of Bounds, its energy is greater. Mars is already a powerhouse of energy. When OOB is can cause greater energy, anger, arguing, fighting or the ability to really make a change.

March 2, 2003 - Venus enters Aquarius Venus in fixed, air can feel independent and detached wanting more freedom in relating, not wanting to be tied down.

March 2, 2003 - New Moon 12 Pisces 06 - This is a terrific time for starting new projects and new beginnings. Pisces is a mutable (changeable, flexible) water sign and loves to give to selflessly to others.

March 4, 2003 - Mercury enters Pisces - Mercury is intuitive and perceptive here swimming in the unconscious. Lack of clarity and indecisiveness is possible.

March 4, 2003 - Mars enters Capricorn - Mars feels a bit restricted in earthy Capricorn but enjoys being grounded in a way to produce positive results and is a little more reliable and predictable.

March 3-9, 2003 - Gather the Women - International Woman's Day - An International celebration of the feminine Spirit. See: www.gatherthewomen.org

March 8, 2003 - Juno turns Retrograde (rx) at 20 Scorpio 29 - Juno is about commitment, partnership and the marriage partner...what we are committed to. Scorpio is intensity, sexuality and penetrating the depths of desire and the psyche. When retrograde, we may retreat or take a second look at what and who we are committed too. This isn't necessarily a bad thing.

March 10, 2003 - Uranus enters Pisces - Big change here as Uranus (erratic, iconoclast) moves from the comfort of its own sign to the wispy, mutable, watery Pisces.

March 17, 2003 - St. Patrick's Day - Have a safe one!

March 18, 2003 - Full Moon 27 Virgo 25 - Virgo is ruled by Mercury, the messenger. Virgo focus is on details, health and the working environment. Mercury is the way we communicate and think.

March 18, 2003 - Spring Equinox - Happy Spring!

March 20, 2003 – Sun enters Aries - Aries is located in the 1^{st} house and here the Sun starts another new cycle in his travels around the zodiac.

March 21, 2003 - Mercury enters Aries - Ideas and communications come more rapidly now. Careful driving!

March 23, 2003 19 Sag 57' - Pluto Stationary Retrograde (rx) until October 22, 2003.

March 27, 2003 - Venus enters Pisces -Compassion and sensitivity is key. Venus feels a certain level of comfort in this sign.

March 27, 2003 - Venus Conjunct Uranus - Unusual Relationships, Sudden Romantic attachments, unpredictable and unexpected financial gains and losses are possible.

Since December 4th, 2002 - Jupiter Stationed Retrograde at 7:23 am EST at 18 Leo 6 and will stay in retrograde motion until April 3, 2003 when is direct its motion, at 8 Leo 3. Much of what we believe about yourselves and the world we live in will undergo some change during this introspective time.

Neptune starts out the month at 11 degrees 26 of Aquarius and will end up at 12 Aquarius 37 on the 31st. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. The symbols were revised by Dane Rudhyar and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. My favorite modern interpretation is written by Lynda Hill. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

NEW MOON March 2, 2003 - 12 Pisces 06

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Pisces rules the 12th, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Starting a new artistic project or dream work is favored as well as establishing appropriate boundaries in your relationships with others.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 13 Pisces:

A Sword, Used in Many Battles, In a Museum

This symbol signifies that many battles were fought and perhaps won. The symbol is one of strength and bravery. Someone must have surrendered in order for one side to win. Sometimes in war, there are no winners. Placing the sword away in a museum might demonstrate the desire to give up the battle or to show others the benefit of either winning and defending or giving up the fight for peace. Perhaps there is a "history" behind this war.

In Tarot, the swords are symbolic of cutting, the cold, callous, sharp individual, decisiveness. Often the mind is a double-edged sword. The sword is a phallic symbol of willpower and male potency.

FULL MOON March 18, 2003 - 27 Virgo 25

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the March 18^{th} Full Moon falls in the sign of Virgo, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Virgo is a mutable, earth sign and resides in the 6^{th} house of the zodiac.. Issues involving your work, ideas, people who work for you, service, pets, and health are emphasized. In medical astrology, Mercury and Virgo relates to the intestines where we process food...food for thought.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 28 Virgo:

A Baldheaded Man in Uniform Has Seized Power.

Again, this symbol is one of masculine strength. A man in uniform is often one in a position of power and authority and looked revered. When a person seizes power they may not be acting in a balanced and grounded manner. If hot headed, he can be destructive and bossy. If level headed he could be a take charge person who may act on your behalf.

Linda Hill likens this symbol to a person "Wearing the pants in the family". These days, that isn't necessarily the male either!
